The standard 12-lead electrocardiogram is a representation of the heart's electrical activity recorded from electrodes on the body surface. This course takes the complex subject of electrocardiography and presents it in a simple approach that gives you a basic understanding of the entire ECG, and how to apply it to ECG interpretation.
