No Cost Training

The Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, has developed a 1.5 day course of instruction, to provide schools and school districts with the tools needed to produce a high quality multihazards emergency operations plan.

The course was developed in collaboration FEMA and the Federal Department of Education. The training is funded through the Federal GSEM Grant awarded to the State of Connecticut. The training classes will be held throughout the State in the Fall 2016 and Winter 2017.

Who Should Attend

The classes are open to:

- Public Schools and Districts (Including Regional, Charter, Magnets, Agricultural and Technology, Endowed and Incorporated Schools).
- Private Schools (all types and religious affiliations welcome).
- High quality emergency operations plans, require input from many disciplines. The following is a partial list of who should attend: Superintendents, Principals, Police, School Resource Officers, Fire Marshal, Nurse, Public Health, Emergency Manager, Risk Manager, Custodian, Food Service, Transportation manager and elected officials.
