The Connecticut State Firefighters Association Memorial Foundation will be holding a Memorial Fundraiser Dinner on Monday, June 6, 2016 at the Aqua Turf Club. Funds raised will support maintenance and replacement of degrading panels on the Fallen Firefighters Memorial at the Connecticut Fire Academy in addition to completing the site work around the 9/11 Steel Artifact. The evening's guest speaker will be Deputy Chief Dominick Carfi currently serves as the Deputy Chief of Operations for the City of Bridgeport Fire Department. Deputy Chief Carfi is second in command under the Fire Chief of the Bridgeport Fire Department and is tasked with managing 277 uniformed personnel, responding to over 18,000 incidents each year, as well as firefighting operations, training and communications, including protecting the lives and property of the largest city in the State of Connecticut.

Deputy Chief Carfi was assigned to plan and organize a LODD Funeral in March of 1999 of a Single Firefighter fatality. And once again in July of 2010, when The Bridgeport Fire Department suffered one of its greatest losses, with double Line of Duty Death's and Funerals. He has also been awarded the Medal of Valor, Firefighter of the Year, two Unit Citations, and has been commended by the Board of Fire Commissioners for rescuing a child trapped and unconscious in a burning building.
