Cancer Registry

There seems to be an overall higher risk for cancer among firefighters. For some types of cancer, the risk relative to the general population can be 229% higher. However, more comprehensive research is needed to determine what factors are causing this increased cancer risk and how to prevent it.

To facilitate this research, Representatives Richard Hanna (R-N.Y.) and Bill Pascrell (D-N.J.) and Senators Robert Menedez (D-N.J.) and Lisa Murkowski (R-Ark) introduced the Firefighter Cancer Registry Act (H.R. 4625/S.2799). This legislation would create an anonymous, voluntary cancer registry for firefighters at the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

The data would include important information about the firefighter's medical history, demographic information, number of incident responses and years in service, whether the firefighter was a volunteer firefighter, what other jobs the firefighter may have had and other risk factors. This registry's goal will be to help researchers reduce the occurrence of cancer in the fire and emergency service.
