Candidate will obtain YNHSH medical control within 12 months of hire date and maintain in accordance with CBA as a condition of employment. Must have graduated from High School or possess a recognized GED.

Career Fire Fighter Dies After Falling Down Unsecured Elevator Shaft While Searching for the Origin of a Smoldering Fire—Illinois

A career fire fighter fell down an unsecured elevator shaft while searching for the origin of a smoldering fire in a warehouse that was undergoing renovations. Crews were searching the second floor in near-zero visibility when the fire fighter fell down an elevator shaft.
