

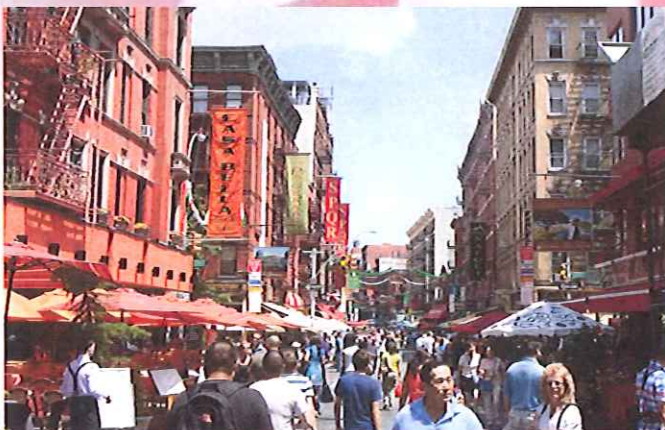

**9/11 Memorial Museum:** The country's principal institution concerned with exploring the events of 9/11 & documenting the impact & significance of those events. Multimedia displays, artifacts and narratives commemorate the lives of each & every victim of both the 2001 & 1993 attacks. The Museum's 110,000 square feet is located in the archaeological heart of the World Trade Center site.

**The Memorial:** The names of every person who died in the terrorist attacks are inscribed in bronze around the twin memorial pools.
