It requires setting up an entire mass fatality operation. We are in need of volunteers either as individuals or as organized groups to participate in assisting with the build for this event. The dates are October 18^{th} through October 31^{st} . During the days of the build we will be serving lunch. The registration to the program is free it will be held on October 25, 26,27.
