CPAT cancellations by the Connecticut Fire Academy

Parameters set by the International Association of Firefighters and the International Association of Fire Chiefs has set very high standards for the proper delivery of CPAT. Maintaining consistency for ALL candidates is a priority. **Therefore, CPAT may be cancelled due to a number of conditions affecting the testing.** The main reason for cancellation is **adverse weather**.

The weather can be very unpredictable. Do not rely on your local weather reports, as conditions may be different at the test site. It is highly recommended that you call (860) 264-9240 PRIOR to traveling to the test site. There will be a prerecorded message stating that the test is either running or has been cancelled.

Unfortunately, the test can be cancelled at the last minute. If you are traveling a long distance, we encourage you to call several times during your travel.

If the CPAT test is cancelled, the message will state how and/or when you will be notified of the rescheduled CPAT test date.
