prohibits discrimination in:

**EMPLOYMENT, HOUSING, PUBLIC
ACCOMMODATIONS, AND CREDIT TRANSACTIONS**

On the basis of:

age
alienage
ancestry
color
disability

(past and present intellectual, mental, learning, and physical disabilities, including, but not limited to, blindness, deafness, mobility impairments, and use of a guide dog or guide dog in training)

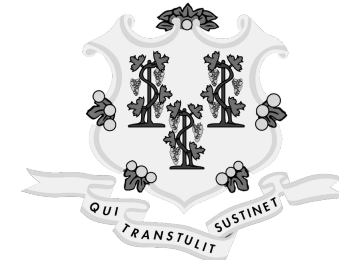
familial status
(housing only)

gender identity or expression
genetic information
(employment only)
lawful source of income
(housing and public accommodations only)

marital status
national origin
race
religious creed
sex

(including pregnancy, childbirth and related conditions, accommodations for pregnancy, breastfeeding, and sexual harassment)

sexual orientation
status as a veteran
status as a victim of domestic violence
status as a victim of sexual assault
status as a victim of trafficking in persons
criminal conviction
(state employment and licensing only)
erased criminal history
retaliation for protected activity
(including filing with CHRO)
