DCJ

- Received 82K data records into the eProsecutor Production Support Environment for User Acceptance Testing
- Scheduled to begin receiving 10 years of production data into the Production environment during the last week of July
- Case Update, Schedule Notification, Disposition enabled in Production environment upon successful completion of production data load

- Currently sending Case Update/Schedule Notification/Disposition through CISS to Downstream Agencies in UAT environment
- CISS/Criminal interface currently in Sprint 4 of 4
- Production data exception report complete

RMS VENDORS


- NexGen completed level II development with full integration testing with full arrest package underway
- Accucom has begun sending level II arrest packages thru the SYSTEST environment

DESPP

- Continue DESPP/CISS partnership for implementation of LiveScan
- New data exchange to support MNI/CCH refresh scheduled for completion in August




GA Deployment



- Installation of new NexGen RMS module completed within Clinton PD
- Upon successful completion of workflow pilot at Clinton PD, Police Departments within GA9 will be phased in during the 4th quarter of 2020
- GA9 Police Departments in scope are Chester, Clinton, Cromwell, Deep River, Durham, East Haddam, East Hampton, Essex, Haddam, Killingworth, Middlefield, Middletown, Old Saybrook, Portland, and Troop F in Westbrook





EARLY ARREST WORKFLOW


 Deployment will resume when Judicial Messages are Streaming in CISS Production – Next Several Weeks

- Connectivity has been handed over to DAS/BEST Project that is replacing all of the PSDN Routers


AGENCY TRAINING

 Fairfield, Stamford, Branford, New Haven, Wilton
 1000 potential new users
- N. Haven Training Academy with 30-40 new cadets
 - Successful Train-the-Trainer at New Haven Academy





Deployment Project Progress




- 32% of the Phase I Project Plan Tasks been completed
- 13 PDs all Deployment Tasks for Search and Workflow (Level 1 EAN) are Complete
- 14 PDs are waiting for RMS Vendor to turn on new software, ALL CJIS work is complete
- 16 PDs are currently sending Early Arrests, Deployment stopped until Automated Dispositions Holding
- 25 Additional PDs are now ready to send EANs when Automated Dispositions are enabled Holding



RMS Vendor Development Progress

NEXGEN

- Level 2 A full Arrest Package (Arrest Packet, Documents, Transmittal) sent through CISS
 - Arrived at DCJ and at Judicial Court Clerk Processing as an (electronic arrest paperwork)
- Clinton Pseudo-Prod Server Active sending Arrest Packages and Receiving Agency Messages
 - Will allow actual arrests to move through CISS for integrated multi-agency testing



ACCUCOM

- First Level 2 Arrest Packet submitted 4/3/2020 passed into CISS, CJIS Validation work beginning CENTRAL SQUARE
 - IMC Level I Kickoff scheduled for October 2020
 - INFORM Initiated Contract Discussions

UPCOMING (RMS Vendors are looking for)

- Agency Response Messages from DCJ and Judicial Systems
- Judicial outbound publishing: Case Updates/Dispositions/Schedule Notifications

CHALLENGES

- Current environment impacting law enforcement availability

CJIS COVID-19 RESPONSE

- Public Safety Liaisons (PSLs) were limited, then grounded
- Networking, Training, Demos, and Project Planning have all been successfully transitioned to using online technology and webinars





CISS Usage (Search and L1 Workflow)

Note: Search and Workflow Users have overlap in the CJIS Community



CISS Key Project Risks & Mitigation

#1 RMS Vendor Participation Does Not Provide 90% + of All Arrests to CISS Mitigation:


- ➤ Contract largest RMS vendors with CISS to get 90%+ arrest information in the state
- Support Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) to migrate to RMS vendors connected to CISS
- > CISS Connectivity as required Standards in CT Contracts and add in new legislation.
- Provide solution(s) for LEAs with non-CISS connected RMS



#2 Stakeholder Support. Current CJIS Agency state budgets do not include funding for resources to implement the CISS.

Mitigation:

> Tiger Teams - CJIS will continue to provide technical and logistical resources support to Agencies for CISS implementation.






CISS Key Project Risks & Mitigation

#3 COVID-19 pandemic will cause delays and increase costs in the deployment of CISS Workflows and Search.

Mitigation:


- CJIS is working with each Stakeholder impacted by the COVID-19 to help with any CISS deployment work by offering resources that may be needed.
- ➤ We are also moving CISS scope from the future to the present that must be completed in order to successfully deploy CISS with the funding and schedule planned.



#4 Contract closure with Conduent, (vendor who built part of CISS) will require some negotiation for open defect not resolved.

Mitigation:


- > CJIS is working with Conduent and Software AG to solve the issue.
- Second, we are getting a proposal for Software AG to solve the issue if Conduent cannot.
- > Third, we have started meetings with Conduent to negotiate a resolution to fix the defect.



#5 SharePoint, Software AG, MultiVue and Other Key Applications in CISS need to be upgraded over the next 12 months or significant issues will occur.

Mitigation:

Plans are in place to do the upgrades but this will add some delays to the deployment phase.
