RE: **DOCKET NO. 500** - Arx Wireless Infrastructure, LLC Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 1061-1063 Boston Post Road, Milford, Connecticut.

On September 30, 2021, pursuant to the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(a), Arx Wireless Infrastructure, LLC (Arx) filed a Petition for Reconsideration of the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) September 24, 2021 final decision to issue a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) to Arx for the above-referenced telecommunications facility at 1061-1063 Boston Post Road in the "proposed location," as defined in the Council's September 24, 2021 final decision.

Arx claims good cause for reconsideration has been shown under CGS §4-181a(a) for the Council to vote to affirm its September 24, 2021 by a "clear majority vote."

In its Petition for Reconsideration, Arx specifically requests the Council to:

1. Grant its Petition for Reconsideration and conduct a new vote on the application at a meeting;
2. Vote to approve the application subject to consideration of moving the facility to the "alternate location," as defined in the Council's September 24, 2021 final decision; and
3. Vote on whether to move the facility from the approved proposed location to the alternate location.

The Petition for Reconsideration of the Council's September 24, 2021 final decision to issue a Certificate to Arx at the proposed location will be placed on the Council meeting agenda scheduled for October 21, 2021.

Parties and intervenors are requested to submit comments or statements of position in writing to the Council with respect to whether the Petition for Reconsideration should be granted or denied before the close of business on **October 8, 2021**.
