Good Evening Melanie,

I hope you are doing well and having a good start to 2026.

I am writing on behalf of the Woodbridge Newton Neighborhood Environmental Trust regarding the above-referenced matter. I understand that the Siting Council will be considering the Development and Management Plan (“D&M Plan”) during its meeting on January 8, 2026. In light of the D&M Plan review, my clients have the following concerns:

1. The D&M Plan repeatedly refers to a monopole structure. However, it is my client’s understanding that Cellco agreed to a monopine tower design to conceal the tower antennas and a portion of the tower to minimize visual impacts. See R. 2081 and R.2100 in the administrative record. My clients urge the Siting Council to (i) discuss this subject during the D&M Plan review; and (ii) require a monopine tower design, consistent with Cellco’s previous concession and agreement, before rendering a decision on the D&M Plan.

2. It appears that the cell tower’s location in the D&M Plan has moved from the proposed location as depicted in Figure 8 of the Siting Council’s Findings of Fact. If the location has been changed, there will be an impact on other property owners that was not contemplated during the Council’s prior proceedings. My clients ask that the cell tower’s exact location (and any consequential impacts on abutting landowners) be discussed and vetted during the D&M Plan review.

I appreciate the Siting Council’s time and attention to these concerns.
