### <u>CITY OF NEW BRITAIN'S</u> REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The Intervenor, City of New Britain respectfully requests an extension of time from October 2, 2021 until November 5, 2021 within which to file its post-hearing brief and/or proposed findings of fact. In support of this request, the Intervenor represents that the property owned by Eversource and located on 148 Farmington Avenue and the cemetery owned by Bethalom Cemetery Association, Inc. and located at 48 Allen Street were discussed at the September 2, 2021 hearing as potential alternative sites. The Mayor's Chief of Staff has recently reached out to the lobbyist for Eversource and a representative of the Bethalom Cemetery and additional time is necessary to determine if either of these alternative sites are viable options instead of the site located at 43 Osgood Avenue, which is the subject of Docket No. 503.

Counsel for ARX Wireless Infrastructure, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T were contacted via electronic mail on September 10, 2021 and there is an objection to this request.
