

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on or about June 4, 2021, by Arx Wireless Infrastructure, LLC ("ARX" or the "Applicant"). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility in the eastern portion of an approximately 11.24 acre parcel at Lot N-4, Sequin Drive, Glastonbury, Connecticut. ARX proposes to construct a 115-foot tall monopole (maximum height not to exceed 115' with antennas) within a 50' x 50' fenced (chain link) equipment compound within a 50 x 50' leased area. Access to and from the Site will be from Sequin Drive. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq. On the day of the Siting Council public hearing on this proposal, ARX may be asked to fly a balloon at the height of the proposed tower described above. ARX will hold a virtual site visit on the day of the public hearing.
