THE HEARING OFFICER: Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. This remote public hearing is called to order this Tuesday, September 28, 2021, at 6:30.

My name is John Morissette, Member and Presiding Officer of the Connecticut Siting Council.

Other members of the Council are Robert Silvestri; Daniel P. Lynch, Jr.; Ed Edelson.

Members of the staff are Melanie Bachman,

Executive Director and Staff Attorney; Robert

Mercier, siting analyst; and Lisa Fontaine, fiscal
administrative officer.

As everyone is aware, there is currently a statewide effort to prevent the spread of the coronavirus. This is why the Council is holding this remote public hearing, and we ask for your patience. If you haven't done so already, I asked everyone please mute their computer audios and telephones now.

This is a continuation of a remote public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is available on the Council's Docket 505 webpage along with a record

of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this remote public hearing, and the Council's citizen's guide to siting council procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Haddam Quarter Solar, LLC, for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at south of Haddam Quarter Road and north of Johnson Lane in Durham, Connecticut.

This application was received by the Council on July 9, 2021. The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this remote public hearing was published in the Middletown Press on August 4, 2021.

Upon this Council's request, the Applicant erected a sign at the proposed site so as to inform the public of the name of the Applicant, the type of the facility, the remote public hearing date and contact information for the Council.

This remote public comment session is reserved for the public to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during the public comment session was Tuesday, September 21, 2021. No member of the public signed up to speak.

Please be advised That written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

Just a quick note on remote public hearings.

Remote public hearings are quite different from in-person public hearings. For in-person public hearings members of the public would sign in, step up to the podium and offer their comments.

For remote public hearings the public is required to sign up to speak well in advance in order to provide counsel staff with the time necessary to facilitate connection and precautions to prevent interruptions, or in common terms, "bombing" of the procedure.

There are protocols, procedures and consistency measures that are followed as part of the remote public hearing process. Written comments may be submitted within 30 days of this public hearing.

I request the Applicant to make a brief presentation for the public describing the proposed facility. Attorney Baldwin, could you identify who's going to make the brief presentation?

MR. BALDWIN: Mr. Morissette, in light of our late change in our witness panel today, as we talked about earlier, I've been elected to take on that task. So I'll be giving the presentation.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Thank you, Attorney Baldwin.

MR. BALDWIN: Again for the record, my name is Ken
Baldwin. I'm a lawyer with Robinson & Cole, and I
represent Haddam Quarter Solar, LLC, Louth Callan
Renewables and Madison Energy Investments in this
project, which is the development of a 2.8
megawatt AC solar facility in Northeast Durham.

What you see on the screen is a overall locus plan that is included in the application materials sheet OP-1.

What this map shows, with an aerial map as a base map, is a 49-acre parcel outlined in the dashed line that Louth Callan renewables has leased from the property owner.

The lower portion where the solar arrays are shown is a 10.9 acre portion of the larger 49-acre

parcel that would be used for the solar facility.

This portion of the site is located south of

Hersig Brook and north of Johnson Lane.

The project maintains, as we discussed earlier today in the evidentiary session, maintains adequate and appropriate setbacks from environmental resources on the property, setbacks from property lines and from Johnson Lane.

Access -- if we could go to the next slide?

Thank you. Access to the solar facility is

proposed from two separate driveways, one on the

eastern end of the project area and one on the

western end of the project area. Those are shown
as those T-shaped structures.

That will be used for access during operation of the facility and maintenance of the facility.

Landscaping is proposed along Johnson Lane in accordance with direction that the Applicant received from the Town during the local consultation process. That landscaping includes a combination of maintaining existing vegetation to the extent that that's possible with the introduction of additional vegetation along Johnson Lane to provide for some screening of the proposed facility given the grades in the area and

the grades along Johnson Avenue which are in some cases higher than the project area. The screening is limited in those areas.

Again, as requested by the Town the project incorporates a farm-like fence as opposed to the originally proposed chain-link fence which was discussed during, again the local consultation meetings.

Interconnection of the facility to the distribution, the Eversource distribution system would be commenced on the southwesterly portion of the project area and tie into existing distribution service, which would be upgraded along Johnson Lane.

Thank you, Mr. Morissette.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Thank you, Attorney Baldwin.

Before closing the evidentiary record in this matter, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any Party or Intervener no later than October 28, 2021.

The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council. Rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties or interveners.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervener, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact and thereafter parties and interveners may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record.

However no new information, no new evidence, no argument and no reply briefs without our permission will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed with the Durham Town Clerk's office.

I hereby declare this hearing adjourned and thank you everyone for your participation.
