Dear Executive Director Bachman:

This letter is respectfully submitted on behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS LLC ("AT&T"), the Applicant in the above referenced Docket in response to the Siting Council's request for an extension of the decision deadline in this docket and a tolling agreement under federal regulations. The Applicant hereby grants the requested extension/tolling of time for a decision in Docket 506 to April 4, 2022. The purpose of the extension/tolling agreement is to permit the newly admitted parties in Docket 506 to present any further evidence in the docket and the Applicant to provide supplemental information requested by the Council as set forth in the revised schedule as recently published.

We do also wish to note that under federal regulations, the time for decisions by state or local agencies run concurrently when multiple requests and permit applications are pending and irrespective of state procedures and timelines. As such, on behalf of AT&T this extension/tolling agreement applies to FP-ATT-083-211214 as well which was raised by the Applicant in Docket 506 and which the Council elected to open as a separate, but related proceeding. While we understand the Council may adopt a schedule for that proceeding in January, the Applicant respectfully submits that the evidence in Docket 506 to date supports approval under state siting criteria and that FP-ATT-083-211214 would be a moot and unnecessary proceeding should the Council issue a Certificate for the project as proposed by AT&T and consented to by the City.
