## **Decision and Order**

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §16-50p, and the foregoing Findings of Fact and Opinion, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) finds that the effects associated with the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility, including effects on the natural environment, ecological balance, public health and safety, scenic, historic, and recreational values, agriculture, forests and parks, air and water purity, and fish, aquaculture and wildlife are not possible to weigh when compared to the specific need for the proposed facility, which has not been established in evidence, and as such, cannot be determined to be in harmony with policies of the state. Therefore, the Council will deny this application without prejudice and will not issue a Certificate for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility at 499 Mile Lane, Middletown, Connecticut.
