Paul Kenline, being duly sworn, states:

1. I am a Senior Project Manager for The United Illuminating Company (“UI” or the “Company”). My business address is 100 Marsh Hill Road, Orange, Connecticut. I am over the age of eighteen and understand the obligation of making statements under oath.

2. I am familiar with the Connecticut Siting Council’s (the “Council”) Docket No. 508 concerning the Company’s application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (“Certificate”) for the Milvon to West River Railroad Transmission Line 115-kV Rebuild Project (the “MWR Rebuild Project”).

3. I submit this affidavit in support of UI's Motion for Protective Order as it relates to certain information requested by the Council in connection with the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the MWR Rebuild Project that describes the seasonal construction restrictions in identified species habitats and the location of herpetological exclusionary fencing (the "Confidential Information") filed contemporaneously herewith.

4. The Confidential Information contains highly sensitive information that UI considers cannot be subject to public disclosure.

5. To the best of my knowledge, the Company has heretofore used best efforts to keep and maintain the Confidential Information strictly confidential in order to protect the identified species habitat, and thereby, avoid the harm that would result to these species if the information were to become publicly available. To the best of my knowledge, this information has not been disclosed or released to the public.


6. I have been advised by UI's legal counsel that neither federal nor Connecticut law require the Confidential Information to be filed in the public record.
