NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF HIGH VOLTAGE ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINES

United Illuminating (UI) Plans Rebuilds to the Electric System to Maintain System Reliability

Benefits to Region: The rebuilds will improve the reliability and resiliency of the transmission system, ensuring that the safe and reliable transmission of power is maintained for our customers throughout New Haven County, in accordance with the National Electric Safety Code (NESC) and federal reliability standards.

Project Summary: The proposed transmission system improvements, known as the Milvon to West River Railroad Transmission Line 115-kV Rebuild Project (Project), will involve rebuilding the transmission lines along approximately 9.5 miles of the Connecticut Department of Transportation's (CTDOT's) railroad corridor in Milford, Orange, West Haven, and New Haven. Between UI's existing Milvon Substation (Milford) and West River Substation (New Haven), UI proposes to relocate its transmission lines off of the existing CTDOT railroad catenary structures (gantry-like steel structures that span the railroad tracks and provide electric service to the trains) and rebuild the 115-kV lines on independent monopoles with new insulators, hardware and conductors. The rebuilt lines will primarily be located along the north side of the CTDOT railroad corridor. The Project also will involve related improvements and modifications to other existing 115-kV structures within the railroad corridor, as well as modifications to connect the rebuilt 115-kV lines to UI's existing Milvon, Woodmont, Allings Crossing, Elmwest, and West River Substations.

The rebuilt 115-kV overhead lines will be located predominantly on CTDOT property. To ensure required clearances surrounding the rebuilt lines in some locations, UI will have to acquire new permanent easements from private landowners adjacent to the CTDOT property.

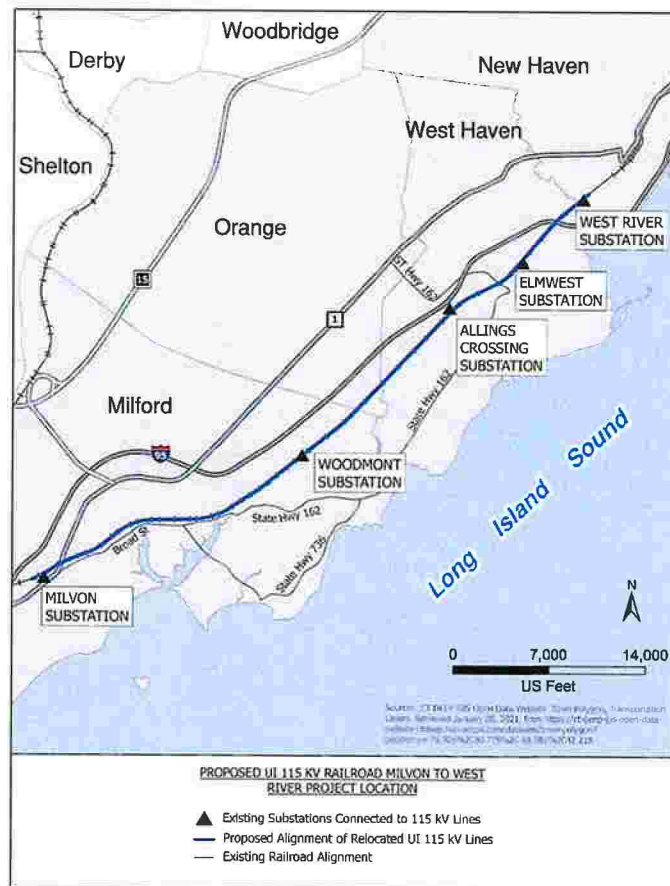
UI plans to submit an application to the Connecticut Siting Council (Siting Council) within the next 60 days, seeking a "Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need" for this project. If approved by the Siting Council, construction is projected to begin in the fourth quarter of 2023. The Project is expected to be constructed in segments, with all work completed and the rebuilt lines in service in the third quarter of 2028.

Technical Description

The proposed overhead 115-kV transmission line structure types are double- and single-circuit tubular steel monopoles with heights ranging between 70 and 170 feet.

UI's application to the siting council will provide additional siting and technical details, including information on how the specific design of the line impacts electric and magnetic field (EMF) levels and a description of measures taken to minimize EMFs. The proposed rebuilt 115-kV lines will meet the requirements of the Siting Council's "Best Management Practices for Electric and Magnetic Fields," as amended. Specific design elements used to decrease EMFs include the use of double circuit structures, with each circuit arranged vertically.

Information regarding Project siting, design, construction, environmental resources, EMF, and planned impact mitigation measures will be included in the application. AVISO DE PROPUESTA DE CONSTRUCCIÓN DE LÍNEAS DE TRANSMISIÓN ELÉCTRICA DE ALTA TENSIÓN

United Illuminating (UI) planea realizar reconstrucciones en el sistema eléctrico para mantener la confiabilidad del sistema

Beneficios para la región: Las reconstrucciones mejorarán la confiabilidad y resistencia del sistema de transmisión, y asegurarán que se mantenga una transmisión segura y confiable de energía para nuestros clientes en todo el condado de New Haven, de acuerdo con el Código Nacional de Seguridad Eléctrica (NESC) y los estándares federales de confiabilidad.

Resumen del proyecto: Las mejoras propuestas para el sistema de transmisión, conocidas como el Proyecto de Reconstrucción de 115 kV de la Línea de Transmisión Ferroviaria de Milvon a West River (Proyecto), involucrarán la reconstrucción de las líneas de transmisión a lo largo de aproximadamente 9.5 millas del corredor ferroviario del Departamento de Transporte de Connecticut (CTDOT) en Milford, Orange, West Haven y New Haven. Entre la subestación actual Milvon (Milford) y la subestación West River (New Haven) de UI, UI propone reubicar sus líneas de transmisión fuera de las estructuras existentes de catenaria ferroviaria del CTDOT (estructuras de acero similares a pórticos que abarcan las vías del ferrocarril y brindan servicio eléctrico a los trenes) y reconstruir las líneas de 115 kV en monopolos independientes con nuevos aisladores, accesorios y conductores. Las líneas reconstruidas se ubicarán principalmente a lo largo del lado norte del corredor ferroviario del CTDOT. El proyecto también involucrará mejoras y modificaciones relacionadas con otras estructuras actuales de 115 kV dentro del corredor ferroviario, así como modificaciones para conectar las líneas reconstruidas de 115 kV a las subestaciones existentes Milvon, Woodmont, Allings Crossing, Elmwest y West River de UI.

Las líneas aéreas reconstruidas de 115 kV estarán ubicadas predominantemente en propiedad del CTDOT. Para garantizar los espacios libres requeridos que rodean las líneas reconstruidas en algunos lugares, UI deberá adquirir nuevas servidumbres permanentes de propietarios privados adyacentes a la propiedad del CTDOT.

UI planea enviar una solicitud al Connecticut Siting Council (Consejo de ubicación) dentro de los próximos 60 días, con el fin de obtener un "Certificado de Compatibilidad Ambiental y Necesidad Pública" para este proyecto. Si el Consejo de ubicación lo aprueba, se prevé que la construcción comience en el cuarto trimestre de 2023. Se espera que el Proyecto se construya en segmentos, con todo el trabajo terminado y las líneas reconstruidas en servicio para el tercer trimestre de 2028.

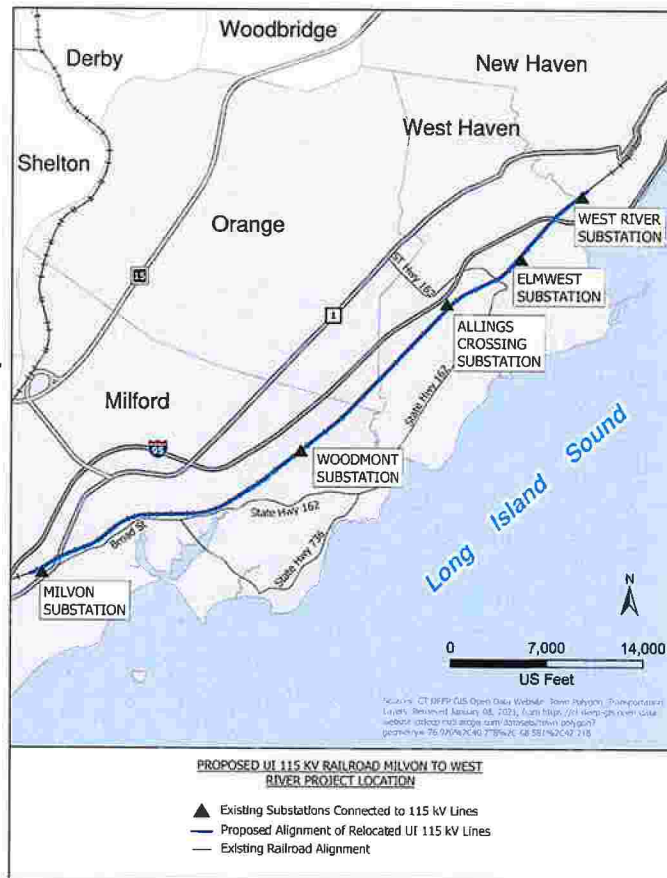
Descripción técnica

Los tipos de estructuras de líneas aéreas de transmisión de 115 kV propuestos son monopolos de acero tubulares de circuito simple y doble con alturas que oscilan entre 70 y 170 pies.

La solicitud de UI al Consejo de ubicación proporcionará detalles técnicos y de ubicación adicionales, incluida información sobre cómo el diseño específico de la línea impacta los niveles de campos electromagnéticos (EMF) y una descripción de las medidas tomadas para minimizar los EMF. Las líneas de 115 kV reconstruidas que se proponen deberán cumplir con los requisitos de las "Mejores prácticas de gestión para campos electromagnéticos" del Consejo de ubicación, y sus enmiendas. Los elementos de diseño específicos que se utilizan para reducir los campos electromagnéticos incluyen el uso de estructuras de doble circuito, con cada circuito dispuesto en forma vertical.

En la solicitud se incluirá información sobre la ubicación del Proyecto, el diseño, la construcción, los recursos ambientales, los campos electromagnéticos y las medidas de mitigación de impacto planificadas. Dear Sir or Madam:

As part of efforts to enhance the reliability and resiliency of the electric transmission grid, The United Illuminating Company ("UI") proposes to rebuild approximately 9.5 miles of its existing overhead 115-kilovolt overhead transmission lines within the Connecticut Department of Transportation's Metro-North Railroad corridor in Milford, Orange, West Haven and New Haven between UI's existing Milvon Substation in Milford and its West River Substation in New Haven. The rebuilt lines will extend along and mostly within the CT DOT/MNR corridor. Referred to as the Milvon to West River Railroad Transmission Line 115-kV Rebuild Project ("Project"), the work will also include other related improvements and modifications including those necessary to remove the existing 115-kV line connections and link the rebuilt 115-kV lines to UI's existing Milvon, Woodmont, Allings Crossing, Elmwest, and West River Substations. The Project will help to strengthen the transmission system and to ensure that UI is able to maintain safe and reliable transmission of power to its customers throughout Fairfield and New Haven Counties.

To that end, UI will ask the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for approval of the Project and its associated construction and operation. Accordingly, on or about February 25, 2022, UI will submit to the Council an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need.

Please accept this letter as notice of UI's intent to ask the Council for approval of the Project.

After reviewing the Application, the Council will hold public hearings to review the Project and to consider input from interested stakeholders. If the Project is approved by the Council, UI anticipates starting construction in 2023 with completion scheduled for 2028. The Council asks that applicants notify all potentially affected community groups as well as the water companies servicing the region of a pending submittal, and UI identified your group or organization as potentially impacted by this Project. The intent of this letter is to allow those notified of their ability to comment or express concerns to the Council.

Did you know...

The number of people who smoke in the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention noted that the percentage of adults in the United States who smoke cigarettes declined from roughly 21 percent in 2005 to 15.5 percent in 2016. That decline has no doubt helped reduce overall cancer death rates, though the figures regarding smoking-related deaths are still staggering.

According to the CDC, smoking accounts for more than 480,000 deaths each year in the United States. The 2018 report from the CDC indicates that men (17.5 percent) are more likely than women (13.5 percent) to smoke cigarettes. In addition, the report notes a correlation between education and the likelihood of smoking cigarettes. While smoking was lowest among people who had graduate degrees, with only five out of every 100 such adults being smokers, smoking rates were highest (40.6 percent) among adults with graduate education degree certificates, or GEDs. While people who had no high school diploma were less likely to smoke cigarettes than GED recipients, the CDC report found that smoking rates declined the more education people received.

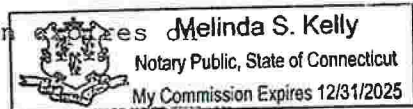

Rebuild 9.5 miles (19 circuit miles) from Milvon Substation (Milford, CT) to West River Substation (New Haven, CT). Relocate the transmission lines off the existing railroad catenary bonnets (overhead wire systems) and install on independent monopoles with new insulators, hardware and conductor in the railroad corridor.

Dear Neighbor:

As part of efforts to enhance the reliability and resiliency of the electric transmission grid, the United Illuminating Company ("UI" or the "Company") proposes to rebuild approximately 9.5 miles of its existing overhead 115-kilovolt (kV) overhead transmission lines that are presently located within the Connecticut Department of Transportation's Metro-North Railroad (CT DOT / MNR) corridor in Milford, Orange, West Haven and New Haven between UI's existing Milvon Substation in Milford and its West River Substation in New Haven. The rebuilt lines will extend along and mostly within the CT DOT/MNR corridor. The work will also include other related improvements and modifications including those necessary to remove the existing 115-kV line connections and link the rebuilt 115-kV lines to UI's existing Milvon, Woodmont, Allings Crossing, Elmwest, and West River Substations. This effort will help to strengthen the transmission system and to ensure that UI is able to maintain safe and reliable transmission of power to its customers throughout Fairfield and New Haven Counties.

On or about February 25, 2022 UI will file an Application with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for the review and ultimately issuance of a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in connection with the Project. This application can be viewed on the Council's website at <https://portal.ct.gov/CSC>.

The Council will undertake a thorough review of the proposed Project and consider input from interested stakeholders, including via comments at a local public hearing. If the Project is approved by the Council, UI anticipates construction to begin in the fourth quarter of 2023 and the Project to be in-service by third quarter of 2028. Please note that this work will not interrupt electric service to homes or businesses.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Rebuild 9.5 miles (19 circuit miles) from Milvon Substation (Milford, CT) to West River Substation (New Haven, CT). Relocate the transmission lines off the existing railroad catenary bonnets (overhead wire systems) and install on independent monopoles with new insulators, hardware and conductor in the railroad corridor.

PROJECT PURPOSE AND NEED

The ISO New England* Southwest Connecticut Transmission Planning study identified that under certain conditions, the reliability of the area transmission system may be at risk. The 115kV transmission lines between Fairfield and West Haven may be subject to damaging overloading conditions which will impact the system reliability exposing the electric system and our customers to unacceptable reliability risks. Due to the physical limitations of the existing Metro North Railroad (MNR) structural support system which was originally installed in the early 1900's, coupled with the reliability risks, it was recommended that new transmission lines be installed on new galvanized steel monopoles along this transmission corridor.
