Dear Ms. Bachman:

The following information supplements The United Illuminating Company's ("UI" or the "Company") September 9, 2023 letter that was filed pursuant to the Siting Council's June 8, 2023 and August 18, 2023 letters concerning the Development and Management Plan for the Milvon to West River Railroad Transmission Line Rebuild Project. The September 9, 2023 letter identified the construction laydown areas for the project at 3191 Broadbridge Avenue in Stratford and at 51 Carlson Road in Orange.

The Company's Erosion and Sediment Control ("E&SC") plan will utilize Best Management Practices and proper erosion controls as required at both locations throughout the duration of the Company's use of the two properties. The Company does not believe that either location will require significant E&SCs since both properties will be mostly paved/gravel lots during the project. The properties will not be used as soil stockpile areas and no subsurface disturbance is expected. The Company's E&SC controls will include:

- The installation and maintenance of silt fence/sock around perimeter of property as required.
- o The installation and maintenance of inlet protection for all drainage on site.

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- The use of dust control measures as needed (i.e., water trucks).
 Equipment brought to and stored at the laydown area will be cleaned free of invasive species prior to mobilization from the project sites.
- To avoid the potential for dumping and vandalism, laydown yards will be fenced and locked.
