Nets beat Pacers to lock up 7th spot, host play-in game Tuesday

NEW YORK — Kyrie Irving scored 25 points, Kevin Durant had 22 points, in a career-high 11 assists and 10 rebounds and the Brooklyn Nets (4-1) defeated the Indiana Pacers (1-7) 113-106 on Sunday in New York.

The Nets will host No. 8 Cleveland on Tuesday in the play-in tournament, with the winner moving into the playoffs as the No. 7 seed.

The loser will have a second chance by hosting the winner of the game between the No. 9 and 10 seeds on Friday.

Brooklyn and Cleveland both finished 4-36, but the Nets won the season series to take the tiebreaker.

Durant had just 5 for 17 from the field but finished with his fourth triple-double, his highest total in any season. Andre Drummond added 20 points, shooting 9 for 5, and 11 rebounds. Irving scored 20 points in the Nets' fourth straight victory to wrap up the regular season.

The Nets began the final week of the finishing ninth or 10th, which would mean avoiding two wins — at least one on the road — in the play-in to get into the postseason.

But they took advantage of a soft schedule in their final days, with victories over Houston and New York before beating Cleveland on Friday.

Offse Brisset scored 20 points for the Pacers, who lost their lead to games in both 25-57. Indiana didn't win after March 30. Today's win added 20.

The Nets made 20 of their first 36 shots — Durant was 6 for 5, the rest of the team 20 for 21 — and opened a 17-22 lead just over a minute into the second quarter.

The Nets led 25-40 at halftime but the Pacers began the third quarter with a 17-20 run to make it a one-point game. Terry Taylor's basket tied it at 9, but Irving made a 3-point ledger. Durant scored and then threw a lob to Eric Claxton for 5, and 11 rebounds. Irving scored 20 points in the Nets' fourth straight victory to wrap up the regular season.

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NHL Eller scores, Capitals beat Bruins for 3rd consecutive win

WASHINGTON — Lars Eller got comfortable in the center and the Washington Capitals (5-1) defeated the Boston Bruins (1-5) 4-2 on Sunday in Washington.

Capitals coach Bruce Boudreau said his team found a groove after a rough start to the season.

Returning to his natural position after two games on the wing, Eller scored the go-ahead goal and assisted on another Sunday to help the Capitals beat the Boston Bruins 4 and extend their winning streak to three.

Eller was mostly back in center because Rickard Rakell's backstom was scratched for what the team called "body malaise" and he made the most of it by putting Washington ahead with 12:18 left and setting up Tom Wilson's third goal of the season.

"It felt very satisfying of course, getting couple of big goals with Connor [Dunn] and Auston [Matthews]," Eller said. "We had a good game going, feeling good on the puck and really happy we were playing."

With Eller in important part of the rotation, Washington's regular kill was a perfect 4 of 4 against Boston's power play.

"The guys were buzzing," said goaltender Viktor Khabibulin, who had to make only three of his 25 saves short-
