MR. MORISSETTE: Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. This remote public hearing is called to order this Thursday, October 6, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. My name is John Morissette, member and presiding officer of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the Council are Brian Golembiewski, designee for Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, Robert Silvestri, Louanne Cooley and Mark Quinlan.

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Members of the staff are Melanie Bachman, executive director and staff attorney, and Lisa Fontaine, fiscal administrative officer.

If you haven't done so already, I ask that everyone please mute their computer audio and their telephones now.

17 This is a continuation of the remote 18 public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this 19 afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is 20 available on the Council's Docket 511 webpage, 21 along with the record of this matter, the public 22 hearing notice, instructions for public access to 23 this remote public hearing, and the Council's Citizens Guide to Siting Council Procedures. 24 25

This hearing is held pursuant to the

provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Barrett Outdoor Communications for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 200 East Main Street Rear, Stratford, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on July 25, 2022.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which is administered by the Federal Communications Commission. This Act prohibits this Council from considering the health effects of radio frequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the extent that the emissions from towers are within the federal acceptable safe limits standard, which standard is also followed by the state Department of Public Health. The Federal Act also prohibits the Council from discriminating between and amongst providers of functionally equivalent This means that if one carrier already services. provides service in the area, other carriers have the right to compete and provide service in the

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same area.

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The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this remote public hearing was published in The Connecticut Post on August 23, 2022. Upon this Council's request, the applicant erected a sign at the entrance of the proposed site as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, the type of facility, the remote public hearing date, and contact information for the Council, including the website and phone number.

This remote public comment session is reserved for the public to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Wednesday, October 5, 2022. No member of the public signed up to speak. Please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

I request the applicant to make a very brief presentation to the public describing the proposed facility. Mr. Gaudet.

MR. GAUDET: Thank you, Mr. Morissette.
Good evening. For the record, my name is Brian
Gaudet. I'm a project manager with All-Points
Technology Corporation.

The applicant for this proposed 135-foot monopole is Barrett Outdoor Communications, Incorporated. The site is located at 200 East Main Street Rear in Stratford. This is an approximately 4.37 acre parcel that is currently owned by UB Railside, LLC. The property is located within a retail commercial district and is developed as a boat storage facility.

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The new compound will be located along the northern property line in the northeastern section of the parcel. Vehicle access to the site will be along the existing paved driveway off of East Main Street to the west and traverse generally eastward and then north into the proposed compound. Next slide, please. Thank you.

17 The compound is roughly 156 feet by 23 18 feet rectangular gravel-based compound surrounded by an 80-foot high chain-link fence with an 20 anti-climb mesh. The compound will be accessed in two locations both 12 feet wide on the southern 22 fence line.

23 Electric utilities will run underground 24 from the existing transformer outside of the 25 compound to a new pad-mounted transformer to be

located within an UI easement to the east of the compound. From there they will run underground to a multi-meter bank on the elevated platform. Fiber will run from the west approximately 1,450 feet to the meter bank on the elevated platform.

The compound has been sized for five carriers, AT&T and four future carriers. Verizon, DISH and AT&T have expressed an interest to collocate on the proposed tower. All equipment, with the exception of any emergency back-up generators, will be installed on the proposed elevated steel platform. AT&T has currently proposed a 15-kilowatt diesel generator with a containment basin to be installed on a new 7-foot by 9-foot concrete pad in the western portion of the compound -- sorry, eastern portion of the compound. Next slide, please. Thank you.

A new 135-foot tall monopole will be located in the western portion of the new compound. AT&T currently plans to install 12 antennas, 12 remote radio units, and two surge arresters mounted on collar mount and sector frames. The centerline of the antennas will be 132 feet above ground level. The tower is also designed to accommodate four future carriers with

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additional lease area within the existing compound and up to a 20-foot monopole extension which would be subject to Connecticut Siting Council process and approval. Thank you very much.

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Thank you, Mr. Gaudet. MR. MORISSETTE: Before closing the evidentiary record in this matter, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervenor no later than November 5, 2022. The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council, rather we leave it to the choice of the parties or the intervenors.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervenor but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

20 The Council will issue draft findings of fact, and thereafter parties and intervenors 21 22 may identify errors or inconsistencies between the 23 Council's draft findings of fact and the record. 24 However, no new information, no new evidence, no 25 argument and no reply briefs without our

1	permission will be considered by the Council.
