Dear Distinguished Members of the Connecticut Siting Council and Executive Director Bachman,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments regarding Docket No. 511.

Based on the submitted materials, it appears that this development may involve the use of 5G C-band technology. While the CAA is pleased to see that the applicants have completed the Federal Aviation Administration 7460 process for evaluating obstructions, it is unclear if the analysis included a review of how the project's 5G C-band infrastructure could impact air traffic at nearby Sikorsky Memorial Airport. Due to this uncertainty, the CAA respectfully requests that the applicants coordinate closely with the airport manager to ensure that any development does not jeopardize the safe operation of aircraft in the vicinity.
