1. I am a Project Manager for The United Illuminating Company (“UI” or the “Company”). My business address is 100 Marsh Hill Road, Orange, Connecticut. I am over the age of eighteen years and understand the obligation of making statements under oath.
2. I am familiar with the Connecticut Siting Council’s (the “Council”) Docket No. 516 concerning the Company’s application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (“Certificate”) for the Fairfield to Congress Railroad Transmission Line 115-kV Rebuild Project (the “Project”).
3. Under my direction and supervision, six notice signs were posted at:

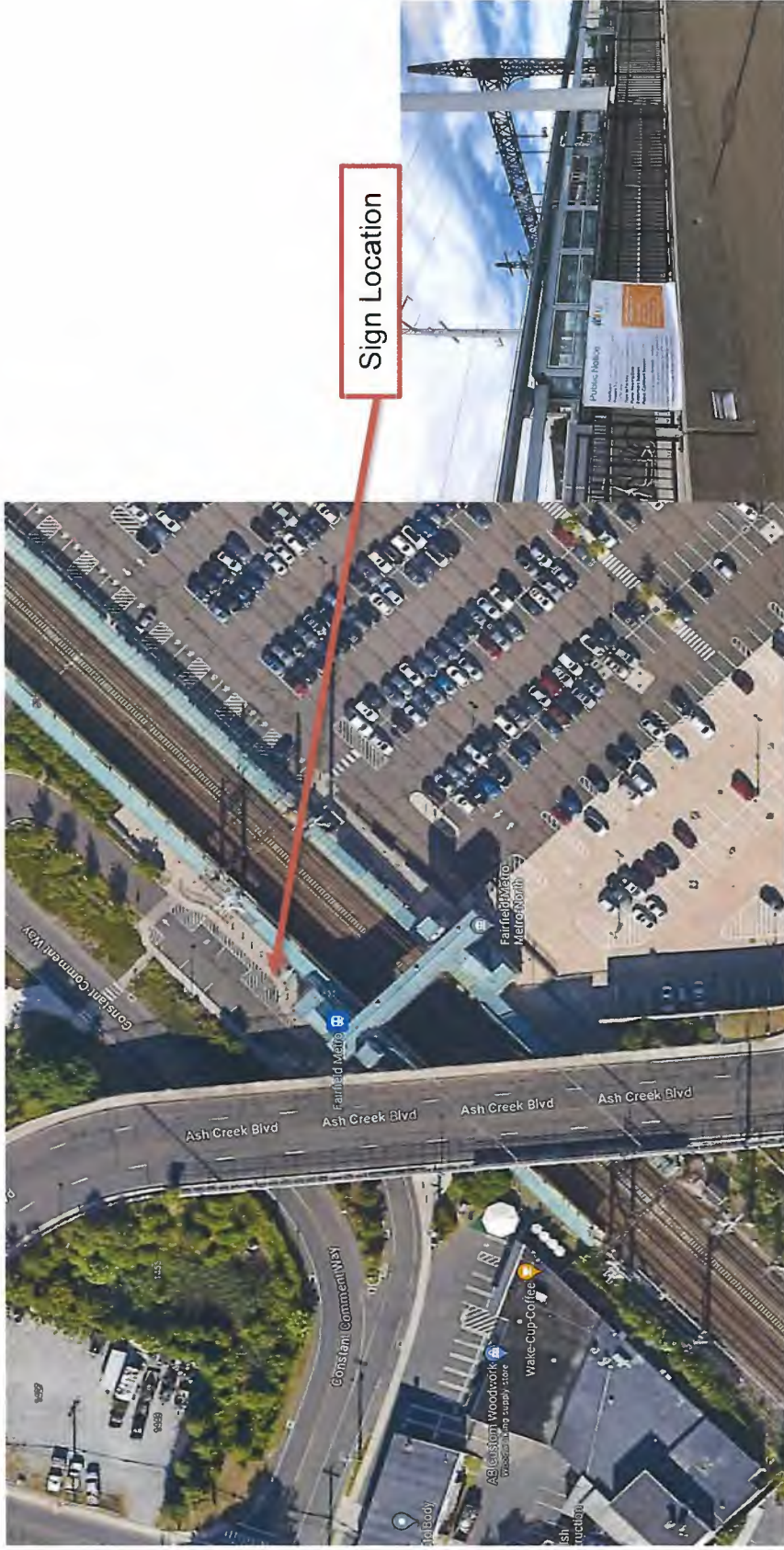
