Verizon's antennas would be installed at a centerline height of approximately 146' above grade level and the Facility will be designed to support the antennas and equipment of other FCC licensed wireless carriers as well as local emergency communications equipment.

### PREVENT HOME HEATING FIRE

- Keep all potential sources of fuel like paper, clothing, bedding or rugs at least three feet away from space heaters, stoves, or fireplaces.
  - Portable heaters and fireplaces should never be left unattended. Turn off space heaters and make sure any embers in the fireplace are extinguished before going to bed or leaving homes.
