1. Manner in which intervenor's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings: I have been a resident of Redding for 18 years. Ten years ago, I established what is now a successful, thriving Nature Preschool in West Redding. I work to protect the health of families and wildlife and I have real concerns about the health and environmental effects of this cell tower and its location.

2. Manner and extent to which intervenor proposes to participate: I am new to this process but I intend to participate in any way that is productive to reaching a reasonable conclusion that ensures the health and wellbeing of all life in the affected area has been taken into consideration.

3. Statutory authority for intervenor request: None

4. Nature of evidence intervenor intends to present: Any research that sheds light on confirmed and potential health hazards related to living, playing, and/or attending school in the vicinity of the tower. In particular, I am interested in the potential impact that construction may have on the Saugatuck River, which runs through our property, on wildlife in the region, which is already facing environmental degradation, and on the health of children at our school, which is near the proposed site for the tower.
