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3 THE HEARING OFFICER: Ladies and gentlemen, good
4 evening. Could everyone hear me?
5 Super, thank you.

This hearing is called to order this
Thursday, December 14, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. My name
is Robert Silvestri, member and presiding officer
of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members
of the Council are Brian Golembiewski, designee
for Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of
Energy and Environmental Protection; Steven
Cadwallader, designee for Chair Marissa Paslick
Gillett of the Public Utilities Regulatory
Authority; and Daniel P. Lynch, Jr.

Members of the staff are Melanie Bachman, Executive Director, staff attorney; Ifeanyi Nwankwo, siting analyst; Lisa Fontaine, fiscal administrative officer; and Dakota Lafountain, clerk typist.

And if you haven't done so already, I'll ask that everyone please mute their computer audio and/or telephone at this time.

This is a continuation of a public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of

the prepared agenda is available on the Council's Docket Number 518 webpage, along with the record of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this public hearing, and the Council's citizens' guide to Siting Council procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, doing business as AT&T, and Tarpon Towers III, LLC, for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 99 Dart Hill Road, South Windsor, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on August 22, 2023.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which is administered by the Federal Communications

Commission. This act prohibits this Council from considering the health effects of radiofrequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the extent the emissions from towers are within the

federal Acceptable Safe Limits Standard, which standard is also followed by the State Department of Public Health.

The Federal Act also prohibits the Council from discriminating between and amongst providers of functionally equivalent services. This means that if one carrier already provides service for an area, other carriers have a right to compete and provide service in the same area.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this public hearing was published in the Journal Inquirer on September 16, 2023. Upon this Council's request, the Applicants erected a sign in the vicinity of the proposed site so as to inform the public of the name of the Applicants, the type of the facility, the public hearing date, and contact information for the Council, which is the website and the phone number.

As a reminder to all, off-the-record communication with a member of the Council or a member of the Council staff upon the merits of this application is prohibited by law.

This public comment session is reserved for members of the public who have signed up in advance to make brief statements. These limited

appearance statements are not subject to questions from the parties or the Council, and members of the public making statements may not ask questions of the parties or the Council.

In accordance with the public hearing notice, and in fairness to everyone who signed up to speak, these public statements will be limited to three minutes. Now please be advised that written comments may also be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

And I also wish to note that parties and interveners, including their representatives, witnesses, and members, are not allowed to participate in the public comment session.

I also wish to note for those who are listening and for the benefit of your friends and neighbors who are unable to join us for this remote public comment session that you or they may send written statements to the Council within 30 days of the date hereof, and that's either by mail or by e-mail.

And please be advised that any person may be removed from this remote public comment session at the discretion of the Council. We also ask that each person making a limited appearance statement

in the proceedings to confine his or her statements to the subject matter before the Council, and to avoid unreasonable repetition so that we may hear all of the concerns you and your neighbors may have.

Please be advised that the Council cannot answer questions from the public about this proposal, and a verbatim transcript will be made of this hearing and will be deposited at the South Windsor Town Clerk's office for the convenience of the public.

Now, at this time, I request the Applicants to make a brief presentation to the public that describes the proposed facility, and Mr. Roberts, I'm not sure if that's you or Mr. Coppins or both.

DOUGLAS ROBERTS: I believe it's me. Thank you.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Very good. Please proceed.

DOUGLAS ROBERTS: Can I share my screen?

THE HEARING OFFICER: We could do that. There we go.

DOUGLAS ROBERTS: Okay, perfect. Thank you. My name is Douglas Roberts, and this is regarding CT-1207, South Windsor, on 99 Dart Hill Road. This is our

cover sheet.

I'll jump to the second sheet, which is really the survey where you have Dart Hill Road at

this point with overhead lines running in a northwest to southeast location. But you will utilize an existing access that Eversource uses to maintain their lines up to this point right here, and at that point we're crossing underneath their utilities into a wooded area for the location of our site in this location -- come on, there.

Maybe? There. Sorry. A little delay here.

The location of the tower is subject to these dimensions. And the sheet after that is probably the more beneficial one, which shows the amount of the -- the area of the compound that's being developed within a lease area of 75 by 75, showing the trees that are located -- being removed for this installation and the access road and turnaround itself.

The next sheet would show the tower elevation, and we have a 165-foot tower, monopole tower, with the top platform being utilized by the Town of South Windsor and AT&T at 155. The left plan shows the layout of the compound with the town equipment on the slab, and AT&T's shelter and backup power adjacent to it.

And the last sheet is just some details of site development. Thank you very much.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Thank you, Mr. Roberts.

We will now call on Marlene Krajewski to make a public comment?

MARLENE KRAJEWSKI: Hi. I don't have any public comment to make. I just wanted to listen in.

Thank you.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Okay. Thank you, Marlene.

Before closing this hearing, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervener no later than January 19, 2024.

The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council. Rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties and interveners. Anyone who has not become a party or intervener but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact and thereafter parties and interveners may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record. However, no new information, no new evidence, no

argument, and no reply briefs without our permission will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed at the South Windsor Town Clerk's office. I hereby declare this hearing adjourned and I thank you all for your participation, and have a good evening. Thank you.
