

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on or about October 26, 2023, by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco” or the “Applicant”). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility in the northeast portion of an approximately 10.9-acre parcel, owned by the Nutrien Ag Solutions, Inc. f/k/a Crop Production Services, Inc., at 11 Chamberlain Road in East Windsor, Connecticut. Cellco proposes to construct a 120-foot monopole tower. Access will extend from Chamberlain Road along a new gravel access driveway to the compound. The tower, Cellco’s equipment cabinets and a diesel-fueled generator will be located within a 50-foot by 50-foot fenced compound. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.
