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MR. MORISSETTE: Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. This hearing is called to order this Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. Мy name is John Morissette, member and presiding officer of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the Council are Brian Golembiewski, designee for Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection; Robert Silvestri; Daniel P. Lynch, Jr.; and Chance Carter.

Members of the staff are Executive

Director Melanie Bachman; Siting Analyst Adam

Morrone; and administrative support, Lisa Fontaine
and Dakota LaFountain.

If you haven't done so already, I ask that everyone please mute their computer audio and/or telephones now.

This is a continuation of a public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is available on the Council's Docket Number 519 webpage, along with the record of this matter, the public hearing notice, and instructions for public access to this public hearing, and the Council's Citizens Guide to Siting Council Procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 11 Chamberlain Road, East Windsor, Connecticut. A complete application was received by the Council on December 28, 2023.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which is administered by the Federal Communications

Commission. This Act prohibits this Council from considering the health effects of radio frequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the extent the emissions from the towers are within the federal acceptable safe limits standard, which standard is also followed by the state Department of Public Health. The Federal Act also prohibits this Council from discriminating between and amongst providers of functionally equivalent services. This means that if one carrier already provides service for an area, other carriers have

a right to compete and provide service in the same area.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this public hearing was published in The Journal Inquirer on January 6, 2024. Upon this Council's request, the applicant erected a sign in the vicinity of the proposed site so as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, the type of facility, the public hearing date, and contact information for the Council, including the website and phone number.

Please be advised that the Council's project evaluation criteria under the statute does not include consideration of property values.

As a reminder to all, off-the-record communication with a member of the Council or a member of the Council's staff upon the merits of this application is prohibited by law.

This remote public comment session is reserved for members of the public who signed up in advance to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Monday, February 26, 2024. No member of the public signed up to speak. Please be advised that

written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

I request the applicant make a brief, very brief presentation to the public describing the proposed facility. And I believe Mr. Centore is going to make that presentation.

MR. CENTORE: Yes. Good evening.

MR. MORISSETTE: Good evening.

MR. CENTORE: Verizon Wireless is proposing to put a 120 foot tower in a 50-by-50 fenced compound on the northeast corner of the existing parcel located at 11 Chamberlain Road. An access drive is proposed off of the southeast corner of the property right off of Chamberlain Road. It's a 12 foot wide gravel access drive that will lead up to the site.

The development consists of creation of that drive, the routing of underground utilities from the road to the proposed facility, construction of the access road, along with drainage improvements. I'll have you please turn to slide C-3 which may shown some of those drainage improvements. It's not in there. Okay.

So the access road, construction of that road, improved drainage swales and basins for

Settlement of water. The compound will house

Verizon's equipment on a concrete pad and provide

space for future carriers to also locate on this

site.

I think the last sheet shows the construction of the facility. The antennas are mounted at a height of 115 feet to the centerline of Verizon's antennas. The top of the tower is 120 feet. And provisions are made to accommodate another three carriers on this tower, along with ground space for additional carriers. That concludes my presentation.

MR. MORISSETTE: Thank you, Mr. Centore.

Before closing this hearing, the
Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs
and proposed findings of fact may be filed with
the Council by any party or intervenor no later
than March 28, 2024. The submission of briefs or
proposed findings of fact are not required by this
Council; rather, we leave it to the choice of the
parties and intervenors.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervenor, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council, may file written

statements to the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact, and thereafter parties and intervenors may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record. However, no new information, no new evidence, no arguments and no reply briefs, without our permission, will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed in the East Windsor Town Clerk's Office.

I hereby declare this hearing adjourned. And thank you, everyone, for your participation, and have a good evening. Thank you.
