Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments regarding Docket No. 519.

While the CAA appreciates Cellco Partnership/Verizon Wireless conducting a preliminary review of the aeronautical aspects of this proposed development, it appears that an initial determination was made that the development could potentially result in impacts to several nearby air navigation facilities. In addition to direct coordination with these respective facilities, the CAA respectfully requests that the project proponents complete and submit Form FAA 7460-1 to the Federal Aviation Administration for approval to fully assess these potential impacts. The 7460 process is extremely important to ensure that this project does not disturb the safe operation of aircraft or air navigation facilities in the surrounding areas.
