

Dear Ms. Bachman:

The Town of Haddam supports the construction of a cell tower at 124 Ague Spring Road in Haddam. The coverage provided by that tower will fill in most of a cell phone dead zone that is a major public safety concern.

The dead zone runs along 7.5 miles of Saybrook Road, State route 154, in Haddam. Saybrook Road is one of the most, if not the most, trafficked road in town. It runs along the Connecticut River from the north end of Haddam south to the Chester town line. The coverage from the proposed tower will fill in approximately five miles of that zone as well as providing cell phone service for the surrounding area. We have had serious traffic accidents on Saybrook Road where the calls for emergency services were delayed by the lack of cell service. And it's not just reports of accidents, any emergency calls from the area are impacted by the spotty or non-existent cell phone service. As a first responder myself, I can attest to how important cell phones are for emergency responders. We use them all the time on scene to augment our radios.

Again, the Town of Haddam supports the construction of the cell tower. It will go a long way to addressing one of our major public safety issues. Thank you for your consideration.
