1 (Begin: 6:30 p.m.) 2 3 THE HEARING OFFICER: Good evening, everyone. 4 Is the Court Reporter with us? 5 THE REPORTER: I am, and we are on the record. 6 THE HEARING OFFICER: Thank you very much. 7 This hearing is called to order this 8 Thursday, June 13, 2024, at 6:30pm. 9 My name is Robert Silvestri, member and 10 Presiding Officer of the Connecticut Siting 11 Council. Other members of the Council are Brian 12 Golembiewski, designee for Commissioner Katie 13 Dykes of the Department of Energy and 14 Environmental Protection; and Chance Carter. 15 Members of the staff are Executive Director 16 Melanie Bachman, siting analyst Ifeanyi Nwankwo, 17 and Administrative Support Lisa Fontaine. 18 If you haven't done so already, I'll ask that 19 everyone please mute their computer audio and/or 20 telephone now. 21 This is a continuation of a public hearing 22 that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of 23 the prepared agenda is available on the Council's 24 Docket Number 521 webpage, along with the record 25 of this matter, the public hearing notice,

instructions for public access to this public hearing, and the Council's Citizens Guide to Siting Council Procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Tarpon Towers III, LLC, and Cellco Partnership doing business as Verizon Wireless for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance and operations of a telecommunications facility and associated equipment located at 1021 to 1041 South Main Street in Cheshire, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on March 13, 2024.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which is administered by the Federal Communications

Commission. This act prohibits this Council from considering the health effects of radiofrequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the extent the emissions from towers are within the federal acceptable safe limits standard, which standard is also followed by the State Department of Public Health.

The Federal Act also prohibits this Council from discriminating between and amongst providers of functionally equivalent services. This means that if one carrier already provides service for an area, other carriers have a right to compete and provide service in the same area.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this public hearing was published in the Cheshire Herald on April 18, 2024. On this Council's request, the Applicant erected signs in the vicinity of the proposed site at the entrance of the 1021 to 1041 South Main Street parking lot on South Main Street and at the rear of the property on King Road so as to inform the public of the name of the applicants, the type of the facility, the public hearing date and contact information for the Council.

As a reminder to all, off-the-recordcommunication with a member of the Council or a member of the Council's staff upon the merits of this application is prohibited by law.

This public comment session is reserved for members of the public who signed up in advance to make brief statements. These limited appearance statements are not subject to questions from the

parties or the Council, and members of the public making statements may not ask questions of the parties or the Council. In accordance with the public hearing notice and in fairness to everyone who signed up to speak, these public statements will be limited to three minutes. And please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

And I wish to note that parties and interveners, including their representatives, witnesses and members are not allowed to participate in the public comment session. I also wish to note for those who are listening and for the benefit of your friends and neighbors who are unable to join us for the public comment session, that you or they may send written statements to the Council within 30 days of the date hereof by mail or by e-mail. And please be advised that any person may be removed from the public comment session at the discretion of the Council.

We ask each person making a limited appearance statement in this proceeding to confine his or her statements to the subject matter before the Council, and to avoid unreasonable repetition so that we may hear all your concerns that you and

your neighbors may have. And please be advised that the Council cannot answer questions from the public about the proposal.

A verbatim transcript will be made of this hearing and will be deposited at the Cheshire Town Clerk's office for the convenience of the public.

Now at this time I request the Applicants to make a very brief presentation to the public describing the proposed facility.

And I believe Mr. Burns, that will be you?

MR. BALDWIN: Mr. Silvestri, we've asked -- good

evening. We've asked Mr. Gaudet, the Project

Manager to do the presentation this evening, a

slight change from the hearing program.

THE HEARING OFFICER: No, that's fine, Attorney Baldwin. Thank you.

MR. BALDWIN: Thank you.

THE HEARING OFFICER: And Mr. Gaudet, whenever you're ready to proceed, please do so.

BRIAN GAUDET: Thank you very much.

For the record, my name is Brian Gaudet. I'm a project manager with All-Points Technology Corporation, representing the Applicants for this proposed 94-foot tall monopole for Tarpon Towers III, LLC, and Cellco Partnership doing business as

Verizon wireless.

As Mr. Silvestri mentioned, the site is located at 1021 South Main Street in Cheshire, and it's an approximately 6.7 acre parcel developed currently by retail and commercial establishments.

The new compound will be located on the west side of parcel in the rear of the existing grocery store. Vehicle access to the site will be along the existing paved driveway off of South Main Street to the east, and traverse generally westward, and then south to the proposed compound.

If we go to the next sheet, please?

The compound is roughly 20 feet by 86-foot rectangular gravel based surrounded by an eight-foot high chain-link fence. It will be accessed by 12-foot wide gate on the northwestern fence line.

Electric and phone utilities will run underground from an existing utility pole that's situated north of the proposed facility to a utility backboard, which will be located off the northwest corner of the compound.

The compound has been sized for three carriers, currently Verizon and then two future carriers. Verizon will install its ground

equipment including equipment cabinets and a 50 kW diesel fuel generator on a 10-foot by 20-foot concrete pad in the southern portion of the compound.

The new 94-foot tall monopole will be located in the center of this compound. Verizon plans to install its antennas and equipment at a center line of 90 feet above grade.

Thank you.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Thank you, Mr. Gaudet.

We will now call upon James Peters to make a public statement. Good evening, Mr. Peters.

JAMES PETERS: Hello. Can you hear me?

THE HEARING OFFICER: I can hear you. Thank you.

JAMES PETERS: Good. My name is James Peters. I live at 190 Brentwood Drive, Cheshire, Connecticut, and I'm speaking in opposition to the construction of this tower.

I responded -- just find out about this a week ago, and I responded in writing to the Council last week with a short objection to this installation. I will put more time into this, into it this weekend and provide a comprehensive objection listing the things that I can't do in three minutes, or I'm not allowed to do in three

minutes.

I'd like to focus my comments in the remaining time on two of the obvious factors, and that one is the line of sight at the public -- I was on the public hearing call at two o'clock. My characterization of the line of sight differs from what was presented at two o'clock.

The Applicants own visual aids in the visual resource assessment that they included with their application has 63 photos; one or two of them are from Brentwood Drive, which is my street. And from the cul-de-sac in the photos provided by the Applicant you can clearly see the mockup of the tower that they provided in those photos.

So I can clearly see the -- will be able to clearly see the tower when it is constructed. The lessors of the property who are located in Cincinnati will not be able to see the tower from Cincinnati.

The second most obvious factor is a noise factor. We, on Brentwood Drive and King Road, have tolerated for years the noise generated by the Big Y, formerly everybody's supermarket. Very early every morning we hear the trucks unloading and the refuse being taken away. We don't need

any more additional noise caused by the addition of this tower and a backup generator.

I plan to meet with the town manager from the Town of Cheshire very soon; we're in touch, and I intend to enlist his aid. Most of my neighbors have just recently found out about this. You will be getting a list of names that -- of people objecting to this, approximately 70, and we will be generating some interest in this.

You should get -- be getting written comment, more written comments in the next 30 days in addition to my own. And I will stop there.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Very good. Thank you, Mr.

Peters, for your comments and for joining us
tonight.

JAMES PETERS: Thank you.

THE HEARING OFFICER: Before closing this hearing, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervener no later than July 13, 2024. The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by the Council. Rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties and the interveners.

Anyone who has not become a party or

intervener, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact, and thereafter parties and interveners may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record, however no new information, no new evidence, no argument, and no reply briefs without our permission will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed at the Cheshire Town Clerk's office.

And I hereby declare this hearing adjourned.

I thank you all for your participation and I wish
you a good evening.
