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1 (Begin: 6:30 p.m.) 2 3 THE VICE CHAIR: Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. 4 Can everybody hear me okay? 5 A VOICE: Yes. 6 THE VICE CHAIR: Thank you. This hearing is called to order this 7 8 Thursday, May 8, 2025, at 6:30pm. My name is John 9 Morissette, Vice Chair of the Connecticut Siting 10 Council. 11 Other members of the Council are Brian 12 Golembiewski, designee for Commissioner Katie 13 Dykes of the Department of Energy and 14 Environmental Protection; Quat Nguyen, designee 15 for Chairman Marissa Paslick Gillett of the Public 16 Utilities Regulatory Authority; Chance Carter; 17 Khristine Hall; Bill Syme; and Daniel P. 18 Lynch, Jr. 19 Members of the staff are Executive Director 20 Melanie Bachman, Siting Analyst Robert Mercier, 21 and Administrative Support Lisa Fontaine. 22 If you haven't done so already, I ask that 23 everyone please mute their computer audio and/or 24 telephones now.

This is a continuation of the public hearing

that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is available on the Council's website along with a record of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this public hearing, and the Council's citizens' guide to the Siting Council's procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Arx Wireless Infrastructure, LLC, and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC, for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility and associated equipment located at 62 and 64 Pershing Drive in Ansonia, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on January 30, 2025.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which is administered by the Federal Communications

Commission. This Act prohibits this Council from considering the health effects of radiofrequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the

extent the emissions from the towers are within the federal acceptable safe limit standards, which standard is also followed by the State Department of Public Health.

The Federal Act also prohibits this Council from discriminating between and amongst providers of functionally equivalent services. This means that if one carrier already provides service for an area, other carriers have the right to compete and provide service in the same area.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this public hearing was published in the New Haven Register on February 23, 2025.

Upon this Council's request, the Applicants erected a sign in the vicinity of the proposed site as to inform the public of the name of the Applicants, the type of the facility, the public hearing date, and contact information for the Council, including the website and phone number.

As a reminder to all, off-the-record communication with a member of the Council or a member of the Council's staff upon the merits of this application is prohibited by law.

This remote public comment session is reserved for members of the public who have signed

up to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Wednesday, May 7, 2025. No members of the public signed up to speak.

 Please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

I request the Applicants to make a brief presentation to the public describing the proposed facility. Mr. Coppins and Mr. Roberts, please?

DOUGLAS ROBERTS: Thank you very much. Again, Doug Roberts.

I guess if we could bring up the drawings?

T-1 would be -- perfect.

Thank you so much.

This is a summary of our project's scope of work, as well as an outline of the address and property owners and the team.

We could jump to the second sheet, which is our existing conditions.

The site itself is a U-shaped parcel, which has for buildings a carwash and a automotive repair facility, which is in the northern portion of it. The remainder of it is a bit of a driveway

for the carwash so they can stack their cars for that.

If I could ask for the next sheet?

This is the existing condition site with an overlay of the compound. We have a compound area of 1800 square feet. We're going to be losing two trees.

And this is a good example of access to the site. We're going to be building the site from the parcel to the north, which is 62. That's why it's also mentioned in the application as so we don't interfere with the operation of the carwash.

So, we'll be building the site from the north of the site, trucking everything out, and at the last minute take down, sort of, the fence to the carwash and the permanent access, which will be from the south side.

Next sheet, please?

Thank you.

And this gives an overlay of how that lays out with the building and the carwash itself. Our compound is in the rear of the parcel, the northeast corner, and we have a pretty tight, tight condition there. So, that's why we're going to be building it from 62 Pershing Drive.

The next sheet would be great.

This gives just a blowup of the compound. We've accommodated four carrier lease areas, 12 by 20, along with an area for the Town if they wanted to place equipment on the site. On the left is an elevation of the tower showing AT&T at their 116 RAD center with a 120-foot monopole, along with the fence and the existing buildings behind.

The next sheet, please?

Some typical details, fence details, meter center details, cut-and-fill details for utilities and grading.

The next sheet is, I believe, our last sheet, and that's just some sedimentation and erosion control measures that we'll be utilizing on the project.

Thank you very much.

THE VICE CHAIR: Thank you, Mr. Roberts.

Before closing this hearing, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervener no later than June 7, 2025.

The submissions of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council.

Rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties and interveners.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervener, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact, and thereafter parties and interveners may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft finding of fact and the record. However, no new information, no new evidence, no arguments, and no reply briefs without our permission will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed at the Ansonia City Clerk's office.
