

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50**l**(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on or about April 7, 2025, by The Towers, LLC (the “Applicant”). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility in the north-central portion of an approximately 55.1-acre parcel, owned by Mark Reynolds, at 835 Route 169 in Woodstock, Connecticut. The Towers proposes to construct a 150-foot monopole tower to be used by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless. Access will extend from Route 169 along a farm road to the proposed tower site. The tower, equipment cabinets, and a diesel-fueled generator will be located within a 50-foot by 50-foot fenced compound. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.
