During the meeting held on January 22, 2026, the Siting Council conducted a non-binding straw poll vote on the application in Docket 535. It was not a *final decision*.

A motion for reconsideration may be filed within 15 days of a *final decision*. The final decision for Docket 535 is scheduled to be rendered during the Siting Council meeting on February 5, 2026. Therefore, your motion for reconsideration is moot at this time because it is premature.
