While the CAA appreciates The Towers, LLC conducting a preliminary review of the aeronautical aspects of this proposed development, due to the proximity of several air navigation facilities in the nearby area, the CAA respectfully requests that the project proponents complete and submit Form FAA 7460-1 to the Federal Aviation Administration for approval to fully assess any potential impacts.
