THE VICE CHAIR: Good evening, ladies and gentlemen.

This hearing is called to order this Thursday,

August 14, 2025, at 6:30 p.m.

My name is John Morissette, Vice Chair of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the council are Quat Nguyen, designee for Chairman Marissa Paslick Gillett of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority; Chance Carter; and Khristine Hall.

Members of the staff are Executive Director

Melanie Bachman, Siting Analyst Robert Mercier and

Administrative Support Lisa Fontaine. If you

haven't done so already, I ask everyone please

mute their computer audio and/or telephones now.

Thank you.

This is a continuation of the public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is available on the Council's website, along with a record of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this public hearing and the Council's citizens guide to the Siting Council's procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the

provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Tarpon Towers III, LLC, and Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility and associated equipment located at 78 Goshen East Street, Norfolk, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on April 17, 2025.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which is administered by the Federal Communications

Commission. This act prohibits the Council from considering the health effects of radiofrequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the extent the emissions from towers are within the federal acceptable safe limits standards, which standards are also followed by the State

Department of Public Health.

The federal act also prohibits this Council from discriminating between and amongst providers of functionally equivalent services. This means that if one carrier provides service for an area,

other carriers have the right to compete and provide service in the same area.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this public hearing was published in the Republican American on May 19, 2025. Upon this Council's request, the Applicants erected signs at the driveway of 78 Goshen East Street and the proposed site access drive at Estey Road so as to inform the public of the name of the Applicants, the type of facility, the public hearing date and contact information for the Council, including the website and phone number.

As a reminder to all, off-the-record communication with a member of the Council or a member of the Council's staff upon the merits of this application is prohibited by law.

This public comment session is reserved for members of the public who have signed up to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during the public comment session was Wednesday, August 13, 2025. No member of the public signed up to speak.

Please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

I request the Applicants to make a brief presentation to the public describing the proposed facility. I understand Attorney Baldwin has the privilege of making the presentation this evening.

Attorney Baldwin, good evening.

ATTORNEY BALDWIN: Good evening, Vice Chair Morissette.

Thank you very much. A pleasure to be with you
this evening.

Again, my name is Ken Baldwin. I'm a lawyer at Robinson & Cole and I represent the Applicant in Docket Number 536, Tarpon Towers III, LLC, and Cellco partnership doing business as Verizon Wireless.

The proposal by the Applicant is to construct a telecommunications facility in the westerly portion of a parcel at 78 Goshen East Street in South Norfolk, Connecticut. The facility will provide service to Verizon Wireless customers to an area of greater than 20 square miles in Southern Norfolk.

The facility will consist of a 186-foot-tall lattice tower, again in the westerly portion of the property as shown here on the site schematic. Access to the facility, also shown on the schematic, will extend from Estey Road a distance

of approximately 940 feet to the proposed tower site.

If we could go to the next slide, please?

The facility will consist of a lattice tower,
as mentioned, in the center of a 73-foot by
73-foot fenced facility compound. Within that
compound, in addition to the tower, Verizon
Wireless will install equipment and battery
cabinets and a propane-fueled backup generator.
Those are located on this plan in the
upper-left-hand portion of the facility compound.

In the upper-right-hand portion of the facility compound is a 1,000-gallon propane tank which would be used to fuel the generator which would be utilized only when commercial power to the facility was interrupted.

Thank you Mr. Morissette.

THE VICE CHAIR: Thank you Attorney Baldwin.

Before closing this hearing, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervener no later than September 13, 2025. The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council. Rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties

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and interveners.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervener but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements to the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact and thereafter parties and interveners may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record. However, no new information, no new evidence, no arguments, and no reply briefs without our permission will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed at the Norfolk Town Clerk's office.

I hereby declare this hearing adjourned.
