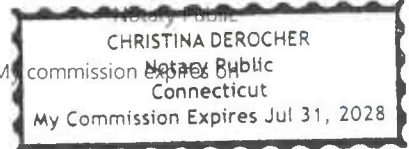

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on or about July 30, 2025, by The Towers, LLC (the "Applicant"). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility on an approximately 13.64-acre parcel at 17 Warren Road in Washington, Connecticut. The Applicant proposes to construct a 140-foot monopole tower in the northwest portion of this parcel. Access to the facility compound will extend from Warren Road over an existing gravel driveway then over a new gravel access driveway. Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco") will install antennas and remote radio heads at the 135-foot level on the tower. Cellco will also install radio equipment and battery cabinets, and a diesel-fueled generator within a fenced compound near the base of the tower. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.
