2 THE VICE CHAIR: Good evening, ladies  
3 and gentlemen. This hearing is called to order  
4 this Thursday, March 26, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. My  
5 name is John Morissette, Vice Chair of the  
6 Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the  
7 Council are Chance Carter, Khristine Hall, Dr.  
8 Scott Williams, Brian Golembiewski, designee for  
9 Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of  
10 Energy and Environmental Protection, and Quat  
11 Nguyen, designee for Chairman Thomas Wiehl of the  
12 Public Utilities Regulatory Authority.

13 Members of the staff are Executive  
14 Director Melanie Bachman, Siting Analyst Ifeanyi  
15 Nwankwo and Administrative Support Lisa Fontaine.

16 If you haven't done so already, I ask  
17 that everyone please mute their computer audio  
18 and/or telephones now.

19 This is a continuation of the public  
20 hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A  
21 copy of the prepared agenda is available on the  
22 Council's website along with the record of this  
23 matter, the public hearing notice, instructions  
24 for public access to this public hearing, and the  
25 Council's Citizens Guide to Siting Council

1 Procedures .

2 This hearing is held pursuant to the  
3 provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General  
4 Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative  
5 Procedure Act upon an application from Cellco  
6 Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless application for  
7 a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and  
8 Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and  
9 operation of a telecommunications facility and  
10 associated equipment located at 0 and 59 Broad  
11 Brook Road in East Windsor, Connecticut. This  
12 application was received by the Council on  
13 December 11, 2025.

14 This application is governed by the  
15 Telecommunication Act of 1996, which is  
16 administered by the Federal Communications  
17 Commission. This Act prohibits this Council from  
18 considering the health effects of radio frequency  
19 emissions on human health and wildlife to the  
20 extent the emissions from towers are within the  
21 federal acceptable safe limits standards which  
22 standards are also followed by the State  
23 Department of Public Health. The Federal Act also  
24 prohibits the Council from discriminating between  
25 and amongst providers of functionally equivalent

1 services. This means that if one carrier already  
2 provides service for an area, other carriers have  
3 the right to compete and provide service for the  
4 same area.

5 The Council's legal notice of the date  
6 and time of this public hearing was published in  
7 the Journal Inquirer on January 12, 2026. Upon  
8 this Council's request, the applicant erected a  
9 sign in the vicinity of the proposed site so as to  
10 inform the public of the name of the applicant,  
11 the type of facility, the public hearing date, and  
12 contact information for the Council, including the  
13 website and phone number.

14 As a reminder to all, off-the-record  
15 communication with a member of the Council or a  
16 member of the Council's staff upon the merits of  
17 this application is prohibited by law.

18 This public comment session is reserved  
19 for members of the public who signed up to make  
20 brief statements into the record. The deadline  
21 for the public to sign up to speak during the  
22 public comment session was March 25, 2026. No  
23 member of the public signed up to speak. Please  
24 be advised that written comments may be submitted  
25 by any person within 30 days of this public

1 hearing.

2 I request the applicant make a brief  
3 presentation to the public describing the proposed  
4 facility.

5 I understand, Attorney Schaefer, you'll  
6 be making that presentation.

7 ATTORNEY SCHAEFER: Yes. Good evening,  
8 Vice Chair Morissette.

9 THE VICE CHAIR: Good evening.

10 ATTORNEY SCHAEFER: Good evening.  
11 Thank you. I'll try to keep it brief.

12 My name is John Schaefer. I'm an  
13 attorney at Robinson & Cole on behalf of the  
14 applicant Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon  
15 Wireless. The site address is 0 and 59 Broad  
16 Brook Road, East Windsor, Connecticut. The  
17 property is up on the screen, as you can see here.

18 The proposed facility is to be located  
19 in the northeast portion of this parcel.  
20 Vehicular access to the proposed facility would  
21 extend from Broad Brook Road over an existing  
22 gravel driveway to the tower site. The proposed  
23 compound will be located at the end of an  
24 approximately 800 foot access roadway with a 60 by  
25 60 foot leased area. And the compound will be a

1 59 by 59 foot compound surrounded by a 6-foot high  
2 fence.

3 The proposed compound has been sized  
4 for three carriers in addition to Verizon.  
5 Outside the fence is the proposed utility area  
6 which will house the utilities' transformer and  
7 utility backboard. The proposed electric service  
8 will be provided via a new underground utility  
9 service from an existing utility pole on Broad  
10 Brook Road.

11 Inside the fence compound in the  
12 northwestern side of the compound will be Verizon  
13 ground equipment which will include an 11 by 18  
14 concrete pad with equipment cabinets, battery  
15 cabinets and a 50 kW propane-fired emergency  
16 generator.

17 At the center of the compound will be a  
18 150 foot tall monopole. Verizon's plan is to  
19 install nine panel antennas and nine remote radio  
20 heads located at a centerline of 145 feet. The  
21 tower will be designed to accommodate additional  
22 carriers at intervals of approximately 10 feet,  
23 and the tower will be available for municipal  
24 and/or emergency use if needed and requested. The  
25 tower will not require any FAA lighting or

1 marking. Thank you very much.

2 THE VICE CHAIR: Thank you, Attorney  
3 Schaefer.

4 Before closing this hearing, the  
5 Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs  
6 and proposed findings of fact may be filed with  
7 the Council by any party or intervenor no later  
8 than April 25, 2026. The submission of briefs or  
9 proposed findings of fact are not required by this  
10 Council; rather, we leave it to the choice of the  
11 parties and intervenors.

12 Anyone who has not become a party or  
13 intervenor but who wishes to make his or her views  
14 known to the Council may file written statements  
15 with the Council within 30 days of the date  
16 hereof. The Council will issue draft findings of  
17 fact, and thereafter parties and intervenors may  
18 identify errors or inconsistencies between the  
19 Council's draft findings of fact and the record.  
20 However, no new information, no new evidence, no  
21 arguments, and no reply briefs without our  
22 permission will be considered by the Council.

23 Copies of the transcript of this  
24 hearing will be filed in the East Windsor Town  
25 Clerk's Office.

1 I hereby declare this hearing  
2 adjourned. And thank you, everyone, for your  
3 participation. Good evening.
