**Objection to ET Industries Post Hearing Comments**

Dear Attorney Bachman:

Homeland Towers LLC and Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, the Applicant in Council Docket No. 548 hereby objects to the Post Hearing Comments filed by the intervenor, Electromagnetic Technologies Industries, Inc. (“ETI”), on June 11, 2026.

As you are aware, the record in Docket No. 548 closed at the end of the last evidentiary session on May 19, 2026. At that time, Vice Chair Morrisett invited parties and intervenors to file Post Hearing Briefs within 30 days but stated, very clearly on the record, that the parties and intervenors would not be permitted to file new information or new evidence into the record.

In its recent email filing, ETI attempts to introduce new evidence and information after the close of the evidentiary record with specific references to a meeting it held with “affected residents in Brookfield” on June 9, 2026, and recent inspections it made of “several alternative [tower] locations” that it believes are “worthy of further engineering evaluation”. Photographs of these alternative tower sites were also attached to the ETI email.

The efforts by ETI to introduce new evidence now, after the closing of the evidentiary record is inappropriate and contrary to the clear instructions from the Vice Chair. ETI has been an intervenor in this proceeding since February 19, 2026, and had ample opportunity to raise these issues before the close of the evidentiary record.

The Applicant therefore respectfully requests that the ETI comments be disregarded and remain outside the record of this proceeding.
