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NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Section 16-50g et seq. of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and Section 16-50j-1 et seq. of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as amended, of the intent of New Cingular Wireless PCS LLC ("AT&T") (the "Applicant") to file an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after February 13, 2026 to construct a wireless telecommunications tower facility ("Facility") at 0 Main Street in the Town of Bethlehem.

The Facility is proposed on an approximately 27.3-acre parcel of land owned by the Town of Bethlehem and identified as Map 10, Block 6, Lot 067 on the Town of Bethlehem Tax Map.

The proposed Facility would consist of a new self-supporting monopole that is 130' tall, with a 4' lightning rod extending above the top of the pole, bringing the total height to approximately 134'. The monopole would be located within a 2,500 square-foot fenced equipment compound within the 5,625 square-foot lease area in the northwestern section of the parcel. AT&T's antennas would be placed at a centerline height of approximately 126' above grade level on the monopole and the Facility will be designed to support the antennas and equipment of other FCC-licensed wireless carriers. The location, height and other features of the Facility are subject to review and potential change by the CSC under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §16-50g et seq.

The Application explains the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and also describes the environmental impacts of the proposed Facility.
