LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on or about April 14, 2026 by Homeland Towers and Cellico Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (the "Applicant"). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility on an approximately 1.85-acre parcel at 402 Clintonville Road in North Haven, Connecticut. The Applicant proposes to construct a 125-foot monopole tower on this parcel. Access to the facility compound will extend from Clintonville Road over an existing driveway then a short gravel driveway extension to the tower. Cellico will install antennas and remote radio heads at the 121-foot level on the tower. Cellico will also install radio equipment and battery cabinet, a propane-fueled generator and a 500-gallon propane tank within a fenced compound near the base of the tower. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.
