Any agency rule or regulation, or part thereof, that conflicts with the provisions of this subsection or diminishes or curtails in any way the rights granted by this subsection shall be void." (General Statutes § 1-210(a)).

If your agency finds that an otherwise public record, in its entirety or any portion thereof, is exempt from disclosure, you should identify the specific FOIA exemption that you assert applies to the material withheld and cite the subsection of FOIA in support thereof.

I address this request to you in belief that you are custodian of this public record. If you are not, please forward this request to the proper custodian of documents and inform me who the proper custodian is at your agency.
