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MR. SILVESTRI: Good evening, all.

This remote public hearing is called to order this

Tuesday, September 15, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. My name

is Robert Silvestri, member and presiding officer

of the Connecticut Siting Council.

Other members of the Council are Mr. Robert Hannon, designee for Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection. Mr. John Morissette, Mr. Michael Harder, Mr. Edward Edelson. And members of the staff are Executive Director and staff Attorney, Ms. Melanie Bachman. Siting Analyst, Mr. Michael Perrone. And Fiscal Administrative Officer, Ms. Lisa Fontaine.

As everyone is keenly aware, there is currently a statewide effort to prevent the spread of Coronavirus. This is why the Council is holding this remote public hearing, and we ask for your patience.

If you haven't done so already, I ask that everyone please mute their computer audio and/or telephone now.

This is a continuation of a remote public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is

available on the Council's Docket No. 489 web page, along with the record of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this remote public hearing, and the Council's Citizens Guide to Siting Council Procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from The First Taxing District Water Department for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 173 1/2 West Rocks Road in Norwalk, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on March 17, 2020.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this remote public hearing was published in The Norwalk Hour on August 11, 2020. And upon this Council's request, the applicant erected a sign at the proposed site so as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, the type of the facility, the remote public hearing date, and contact information for the

Council.

This remote public comment session is reserved for the public to make brief statements into the record. However, the deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Thursday, September 8, 2020. No member of the public signed up to speak. Please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this hearing.

At this time, I'd like to request that the applicant make a very brief presentation to the public describing the proposed facility.

Attorney Baldwin, are you ready to go?

MR. BALDWIN: Thank you, Mr. Silvestri.

Thank you. Again, Ken Baldwin with Robinson &

Cole on behalf of the applicant, First Taxing

District of Norwalk Water Department.

Back on March 23rd of this year, the
First Taxing District, in cooperation with Verizon
Wireless, AT&T Wireless, T-Mobile and Sprint,
otherwise known as the wireless carriers in our
application, filed an application with the Siting
Council for the construction of a new
telecommunications tower on its property at 173

West Rocks Road in Norwalk.

The First Taxing District currently maintains an old water tank on the property that it currently supports antennas of each of the wireless carriers. However, because of its needs to install a new facility, a new water tank at the property, and also remove the existing structure, The First Taxing District, along with the wireless carriers, has developed this application that would allow the construction of a new tower, the relocation of all of the wireless carriers' antennas from the existing water tank to the new tower, the removal of the existing water tower, and the construction of a new water tower in the center of the property.

As shown on the screen, this is sheet C-1 from the exhibits currently a part of the application, this shows the triangular shaped First Taxing District parcel. In the upper right-hand corner of that plan is the existing water tank on which the wireless carriers have mounted antennas. In the center of that drawing you'll see a proposed water tank that The First Taxing District will install, and to the left of that water tank is the facility compound that The

First Taxing District will build, including a 130 foot telecommunications tower, equipment space within a fenced compound for each of the wireless carriers, and two back-up generators that will service AT&T's equipment and Verizon's equipment. In the northerly portion of that compound are two ground mounted propane fuel tanks for the back-up generators.

Also included on this plan you'll see a significant amount of landscaping. The First Taxing District went to great lengths to do what they could to screen at least the views from the adjacent properties, particularly to the south, into the parcel, especially after construction is completed. But you'll see significant landscaping surrounding the proposed water tank, significant landscaping along the entire southerly property boundary, landscaping around the eastern and southern boundary of the telecommunications facility compound, and additional landscaping to the east of the proposed water tank in the area where the existing tank will ultimately be removed from the property.

Access to the site would remain from West Rocks Road. The existing driveway that comes

in off of West Rocks Road to service the existing water tank would be eliminated, and additional landscaping would be installed in those areas so that they are revegetated.

Thank you, Mr. Silvestri.

MR. SILVESTRI: Thank you, Attorney Baldwin. Again, the deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Thursday, September 8, 2020, and no member of the public signed up to speak.

Before closing the evidentiary record of this matter, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervenor no later than October 15, 2020. The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council, rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties and intervenors.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervenor but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council, may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof. The Council will issue draft findings of fact and thereafter parties and intervenors may identify errors or inconsistencies

between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record. However, no new information, no new evidence, no argument and no reply briefs without our permission will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed at the Norwalk City Clerk's office. I hereby declare this hearing adjourned, and I thank you all for your participation. Have a nice evening.
