This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Cellco Partnership, doing business as Verizon Wireless, for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 110 Yantic Lane in Norwich, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on July 7, 2020.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this remote public hearing was published in the Norwich Bulletin on August 29, 2020. Upon this Council's request, the applicant erected a sign at the proposed site so as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, the type of the facility, the remote public hearing date, and contact information for the Council.

This remote public comment session is reserved for the public to make brief statements

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into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Thursday, October 22, 2020. No member of the public signed up to speak, but please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of the public hearing.

I request the applicant to make a very brief presentation to the public for those that might be listening and watching that describes the proposed facility.

Attorney Baldwin, would you do that, please?

MR. BALDWIN: Thank you, Mr.

Silvestri. Again, Ken Baldwin with Robinson & Cole on behalf of the applicant, Cellco Partnership, doing business as Verizon Wireless. As shown on sheet C-1 from the project plans that are included in the application, Cellco is proposing a facility on a 115-acre parcel at 110 Yantic Lane. This map shows the entire 115-acre parcel with the south side located approximately 400 feet south of the existing Norwich Public Utility water tank.

As shown on sheet C-2 of the same plan set, this shows proximity of the proposed south site to the existing water tank and the proposed

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utility access to the facility, to the telecommunications facility, from Philanne Drive over an existing access way in place and used to access the public utilities water tank.

On sheet C-3 of the same plan set, the facility details are shown, and they include a 110-foot monopole tower within a 50-foot by 50-foot fenced compound. At the top of the tower, Verizon will install six antennas and remote radio heads on a triangular platform. The antennas will extend above the top of the tower to a height approximately 113 feet above ground level. Radio equipment, a backup generator, and a propane tank will be installed within the facility compound and that is shown in the upper left-hand portion of sheet C-4. I think I said C-3 earlier.

Access to the facility was originally proposed to come off of Yantic Lane on an existing driveway. That access way is still available to Verizon. Access has also been -- rights to access has also been obtained over an existing access driveway for utilities and vehicular access to the south side off of Philanne Drive.
