RE: DOCKET NO. 492 - Gravel Pit Solar application for a Certificate of Environmental

Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 120-megawatt-AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility on eight parcels generally located to the east and west of the Amtrak and Connecticut Rail Line, south of Apothecaries Hall Road and north of the South Windsor town boundary in East Windsor, Connecticut and associated electrical

interconnection.

During a public hearing of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on November 12, 2020, Gravel Pit Solar's Motion for Protective Order regarding the response to Council Interrogatory #5, dated October 30, 2020, was withdrawn by the applicant.

Continuation of Evidentiary Hearing

The Council shall continue the remote evidentiary hearing session for the above-referenced proceeding on **Tuesday, December 1, 2020** via Zoom conferencing, beginning at **2:00 p.m.** A copy of the Instructions for Access to the Remote Continued Evidentiary Hearing Session is attached.

The hearing shall commence with continued cross examination of the Applicant by the Council.

Applicant's Late-Filed Exhibits

During the November 12, 2020 evidentiary hearing session, the Council requested that the Applicant submit the following information as late-filed exhibits:

- a) Provide a corrected Table 10 from page 56 of the Application;
- b) Cite a source for the 464 MW of installed solar generating capacity in Connecticut noted on page 6 of the Application;
- c) Cite a source (e.g. report) for the ISO-NE power plant retirement (and at risk for retirement) data noted in paragraph two of page 7 of the Application;
- d) Provide a corrected response to Council interrogatory #3 "Offtaker/Buyer Table" to include a corrected "Selection" dates column;
- e) Provide a corrected response to Council interrogatories #43 and #44 "Smallest Wetland/Watercourse Buffer to Nearest Limits of Work" table and Wetland Impact Map; and
- f) Provide a copy of the public comments received from the project website.

The Council requests these late-filed exhibits be submitted to the Council before the close of business on **November 24, 2020**.
