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This remote public hearing is called to order this Tuesday, December 8, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. My name is Robert Silvestri, member and presiding officer of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the Council are Robert Hannon, designee for Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection; Quat Nguyen, designee for Chair Marissa Paslick Gillett of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority; John Morissette; Michael Harder; Edward Edelson; and Daniel P. Lynch, Jr.

MR. SILVESTRI: Good evening, everyone.

Members of the staff are Melanie
Bachman, executive director and staff attorney;
Michael Perrone, siting analyst; and Lisa
Fontaine, fiscal administrative officer.

As all are keenly aware, there is currently a statewide effort to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus. And this is why the Council is holding this remote public hearing, and we ask for your patience.

If you haven't done so already, we ask that everyone please mute their computer audio and/or telephone at this time.

This is a continuation of a remote

public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is available on the Council's Docket No. 494 webpage, along with the record of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this remote public hearing, and the Council's Citizens Guide to Siting Council Procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Cellco Partnership doing business as Verizon Wireless for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located south of Chestnut Hill Road at the intersection with Grilley Road and Lyman Road in Wolcott, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on September 2, 2020.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this remote public hearing was published in The Waterbury Republican American on October 14, 2020. Upon this Council's request, the applicant erected a sign near the proposed access road entering the subject property from

Chestnut Hill Road so as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, the type of facility, the remote public hearing date, and contact information for the Council.

This remote public comment session is reserved for the public to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Tuesday, December 1, 2020. No member of the public signed up to speak, however. And please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

I'd like to request the applicant to make a very brief presentation to the public for those who are joining us describing the proposed facility.

And Attorney Baldwin, would you be doing that for us this evening?

MR. BALDWIN: I will. Thank you, Mr. Silvestri.

MR. SILVESTRI: Thank you.

MR. BALDWIN: Good evening, everyone.

My name is Ken Baldwin. I'm a lawyer with

Robinson & Cole. And I'm here tonight on behalf

of the applicant, Cellco Partnership doing business as Verizon Wireless.

Cellco is proposing to establish a new wireless telecommunications facility on a 10.17 acre parcel of land south of Chestnut Hill Road near its interconnection with Grilley Road and Lyman Road in the Town of Wolcott, Connecticut. That is shown on Sheet C-1 that is currently on your screen. The property is owned by PAL Properties LLC.

Moving on to the second sheet there, the facility will consist of a 120 foot tower located within a 50 foot by 50 foot facility compound fenced and secure, also within a 75 foot by 75 foot leased area. The facility compound is approximately 850 feet south of Chestnut Hill Road.

Access to the facility will be over a gravel access driveway which will extend from Chestnut Hill Road, as depicted here on Sheet SP-1, up the hill to the cell site. This plan shows grading, proposed grading and drainage improvements that would be associated with the driveway to access the site.

The last sheet of these three sheets

shows the details of the proposed tower compound and a tower elevation itself. Again, it is a 120 foot monopole tower with Verizon Wireless antennas mounted to the top of the tower. The equipment associated with the Verizon Wireless antennas would be located, again, within the facility compound near the base of the tower.

Since the filing of this application, AT&T Wireless has also sought intervenor status and was granted intervenor status in this docket, and is looking to share the proposed facility if it is approved by the Siting Council. AT&T antennas would go approximately 10 feet below the Verizon Wireless antennas on the tower, and AT&T equipment would also be located within the facility compound.

Thank you, Mr. Silvestri.

MR. SILVESTRI: Thank you, Attorney Baldwin.

Again, I'd like to reiterate that no member of the public signed up to speak, but please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

And moving to closing, before closing

the evidentiary record of this matter, the
Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs
and proposed findings of fact may be filed with
the Council by any party or intervenor no later
than January 7, 2021. The submission of briefs or
proposed findings of fact are not required by this
Council, rather we leave it to the choice of the
parties and the intervenors.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervenor, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council, may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact, and thereafter parties and intervenors may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's findings of fact and the record.

However, no new information, no new evidence, no argument, and no reply briefs, without our permission, will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed at the Wolcott Town Clerk's Office and the Waterbury City Clerk's Office.
