

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on or about October 15, 2020, by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco” or the “Applicant”). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility in the northwest portion of the Sacred Heart University main campus at 5151 Park Avenue in Fairfield, Connecticut. Cellco proposes to construct a 130-foot monopole tower within a 50’ x 50’ fenced compound. Access to the facility will extend from Jefferson Street over an existing driveway to the cell site. Cellco will also install equipment cabinets, a generator and a propane fuel tank within the fenced compound. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.
