MR. SILVESTRI: Good evening,

everyone. I trust that everyone can still hear me

okay.

This remote public hearing is called to order. This is Thursday, January 21, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. My name is Robert Silvestri, member and presiding officer of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the Council are Mr. Robert Hannon, designee for Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection; Mr. John Morissette, Mr. Edward Edelson, and Mr. Michael Harder.

Members of the staff are Miss

Melanie Bachman, executive director and staff attorney;

Mr. Robert Mercier, siting analyst; and Miss Lisa

Fontaine, fiscal administrative officer.

As all keenly aware there is currently a statewide effort to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus. This is why the Council is holding this remote public hearing and we ask for your patience. If you haven't done so already, I ask that everyone please mute their computer audio and/or telephone at this time.

This is a continuation of a remote public hearing that began at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is available on the

Council's docket No. 495 web page, along with the record of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this remote public hearing, and the Council's Citizen's Guide to Citing Council Procedure.

The hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act upon an application from Cellco Partnership doing business as Verizon Wireless for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 5151 Park Avenue in Fairfield, Connecticut.

This application was received by the Council on October 16, 2020.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this remote public hearing was published in the Connecticut Post on December 11, 2020, and upon this Council's request the applicant erected a sign at the proposed access and road entering the subject property from Jefferson Street, so as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, the type of the facility, the remote public hearing date, and contact information for the Council.

This remote public comment section is reserved for the public to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Thursday, January 14, 2021; however, no member of the public signed up to speak tonight.

Please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

I did request that the applicant can make a very brief presentation this evening to the public for those that are watching and listening that describes the proposed facility. Attorney Baldwin?

MR. BALDWIN:

Silvestri. Good evening. Again, this is Ken Baldwin with Robinson & Cole on behalf of the applicant, Cellco Partnership doing business as Verizon wireless.

Thank you, Mr.

The application before the Council today is to construct a replacement telecommunications facility. It is a replacement facility because the existing rooftop facility on the campus at Sacred Heart University, the legal agreements that allow that facility to be there will be terminated on or about January 13, 2022, and we need to establish a facility to replace that existing cell site.

The cell site would be located in the northwest corner of the main campus of Sacred Heart University. The map you see in front you is a part of the record, sheet C-1, in the application. For orientation purposes, Jefferson Street runs along the top of the campus, the north side of the campus. Park Avenue runs along the east side of the campus. The campus is also bounded on the south and the west by the Fairchild Wheeler Golf Course.

As shown on sheet C-2, the facility will consist of a 50 foot by 50 foot fenced compound area shown as the square. On the left side of that compound area you'll see the proposed monopole tower location. Access to the tower side would be off of Jefferson Street. There is an existing driveway utilized by Sacred Heart University off Jefferson Street that comes up to the top of the hill where the proposed facility compound would be located.

As shown on sheet A-1 of the plan set in the application package, some additional details about the facility, the tower itself. The tower is proposed to be 130 feet tall with Cellco antennas at the top of the tower on a triangular antenna platform.

Within the fenced equipment compound, Cellco will install two equipment cabinets,

some electrical panels, a backup generator, and a 500-gallon propane fuel tank to fuel its generator.

We did learn prior to this evening and was discussed at the evidentiary hearing that T-Mobile has reached out to Verizon regarding its willingness and desire to share the proposed facility. Thank you, Mr. Silvestri.

MR. SILVESTRI: Thank you, Attorney Baldwin.

Before closing the evidentiary record of this matter, the Connecticut Citing Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervenor no later that February 20, 2021. The submission of briefs or proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council. Rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties and the intervenors.

And, again, anyone who has not become a party or intervenor but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact and thereafter parties and intervenors may identify errors or inconsistencies between the
