RE:	DOCKET NO. 495 - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 5151 Park Avenue, Fairfield, Connecticut.

On February 11, 2022, pursuant to the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b), Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (Verizon) filed a Motion to Reopen and Modify (Motion to Reopen) the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) April 8, 2021 decision to grant a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) to Verizon for the above-referenced telecommunications facility in Fairfield, Connecticut, based on changed conditions.

The Motion to Reopen the Council's April 8, 2021 final decision will be placed on the Council meeting agenda scheduled for February 24, 2022 for Council consideration.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b), parties and intervenors to the original proceeding shall be notified of the Motion to Reopen and given an opportunity to participate. There were no parties or intervenors of record to the original proceeding when the final decision on the application for a Certificate was rendered and therefore, there are no parties or intervenors of record to be notified of this Motion to Reopen nor to comment on this Motion to Reopen.
